"By 1963, the selection of specialists had been made. The final study group consisted of 15 experts in various academic disciplines, selected for their expertise in their respective fields.

"Their first and last meetings were held at an underground nuclear survival retreat called Iron Mountain. This study was concluded in 1966.

"President Lyndon Johnson gave the order that the report was never to be released, due to the nature of the conclusions reached. One of the men involved in this study elected to release it to the public at great risk to himself, under the name of John Doe.

"It was published in 1967 by Dell Press. The establishment promptly renounced it as a hoax. It was no hoax. Iron Mountain is now hard to obtain, but many large libraries still have copies of it.

"This report looks deep into the soul of the

1 New World Order. Iron Mountain is the covert agenda to  
2 bring the world, and America, under the control of the  
3 United Nations. The conclusions reached are now being  
4 implemented upon the American people without their  
5 knowledge or consent, as this documentary will prove  
6 beyond all doubt.

7 "What you are about to see and hear is real.  
8 It is very disturbing, yet real. It is dangerous beyond  
9 belief, yet real. It is frightening, yet real. No  
10 person in America is safe because in spite of all the  
11 denials of authorities, it is. And these plans are now  
12 coming to pass.

13 "This report will show you how the 'Rich Men  
14 of the Earth' are now operating and why. You will now  
15 understand why America is changing into a fascist police  
16 state. You will understand why all federal law  
17 enforcement agencies will be soon merged into one  
18 federal police force, called the MJTF Police.

19 "There is no regard for ethics, morality,  
20 religion or life in this report. It is a look into the  
21 soul of Lucifer, the Antichrist, long foretold by Jesus  
22 Christ who, in his love for mankind, warned us 2000  
23 years ago this was coming. It is now here."

1                   NARRATOR: Welcome to the report from Iron  
2 Mountain. This report is something you would never  
3 believe unless you read it, but you also have to  
4 understand the mindset of the government that requested  
5 it, and that is one of the most important features of  
6 this video.

7                   The objective was to determine accurately and  
8 realistically the nature of the problems that would  
9 confront the United States if and when a condition of  
10 permanent peace should arrive.

11                   This is one of the key elements of the report  
12 because we are to go under, under the Antichrist system,  
13 an era of supposed peace.

14

15                   "ITS OBJECTIVE WAS TO DETERMINE, ACCURATELY  
16 AND REALISTICALLY, THE NATURE OF THE PROBLEMS THAT WOULD  
17 CONFRONT THE UNITED STATES."

17

18                   NARRATOR: And this is what this whole program  
19 was about, if and when a condition of permanent peace  
20 should arise.

21

22                   "IF AND WHEN A CONDITION OF PERMANENT PEACE  
23 SHOULD ARISE.

23                   "PEACE = WORLD SOCIALISM."

24

25

1                   NARRATOR: That means that peace in reality  
2 equals world socialism, as we will find out as we  
3 journey through this report.

4

5                   "AND DRAFT A PROGRAM FOR DEALING WITH THIS  
6 CONTINGENCY."

7

8                   NARRATOR: And they were to draft a program  
9 for dealing with this contingency. In other words, this  
10 was a planned situation.

11

12                   "PROGRAM = AGENDA.

13                   "HOW DO WE CONTROL THE PEOPLE OF AMERICA IF WE  
14 MOVE TO AN ERA OF PEACE?"

15

16                   NARRATOR: The program equals the agenda. And  
17 how do we control the people of America if we move to an  
18 era of peace? And not only just America, but the whole  
19 world at large.

20

21                   "THIS 'ERA OF PEACE' WAS PART OF THE AGENDA  
22 FOR EVENTUAL WORLD GOVERNMENT, UNDER THE UNITED NATIONS,  
23 LONG PLANNED BY THE ELITE.

24

25                   "IRON MOUNTAIN WAS ORDERED IN 1961, THE SAME  
YEAR THAT THE UNITED STATES MADE MAJOR MOVES TOWARDS  
DISARMAMENT. THE KENNEDY ADMINISTRATION KNEW THAT THE  
UNITED STATES WOULD HAVE TO BE SUBMERGED UNDER THE  
UNITED NATIONS.

27                   "HOW COULD THE AMERICAN PEOPLE BE CONVINCED TO  
28 GIVE UP THEIR CONSTITUTION AND BILL OF RIGHTS? HOW  
29 COULD THEY BE CONTROLLED, AND WHAT SHOULD THE GOVERNMENT  
30 EXPECT?"

1                   NARRATOR: In 1961, Public Law 87-297 was  
2 passed paving the way for the United States to be merged  
3 with the United Nations. It was a very crucial law in  
4 that it disarms the American citizen in violation of the  
5 clear intent of The Constitution, which calls for our  
6 right to bear arms to maintain our free state.

7                   And by the calling for the disarming of all  
8 Americans, of course we lose our free state and we are  
9 submerged actually into a slave state.

10                   "PUBLIC LAW 87-297 VIOLATES THE CLEAR INTENT  
11 OF THE CONSTITUTION (OUR RIGHT TO BEAR ARMS) CALLING FOR  
12 THE DISARMING OF ALL AMERICANS."

13                   NARRATOR: The disarming was to be done by a  
14 gradual disarmament. And as they were disarming, the  
15 United Nations would be built up with a powerful  
16 standing arm.

17                   The evidence suggests a CFR/TC/Bilderberg  
18 connection, the Rich Men of the Earth, the Merchants of  
19 Babylon, the Killers of the Just, according to the Holy  
20 scriptures.

21                   The report concerns itself with the globalist  
22 agenda, and the conclusions reached have been advanced  
23 by these groups.

24                   Every one of the conclusions in the Iron  
25 Mountain report have been advanced by these groups,

1 committee of 300, the CFR/TC/Bilderbergers, Royal  
2 Institute For International Affairs, Tavistock, your  
3 Club of Rome, United Nations. It goes on and on.

4

5 "THESE HEARINGS TO PLACE THE UNITED STATES  
6 UNDER A WORLD GOVERNMENT WERE HELD IN 1950."

6

7 NARRATOR: Okay. It began back in 1950  
8 actually. These hearings began to take place in the  
9 United States, and the calls for a world government were  
10 actually held in 1950.

11 Here's a resolution in Congress that was  
12 considered and called for testimony. And it says: To  
13 provide a true world government through the adoption of  
14 a world government constitution.

15

16 "TO PROVIDE A TRUE WORLD GOVERNMENT...THROUGH  
17 ADOPTION OF...A WORLD GOVERNMENT CONSTITUTION..."

17

18 NARRATOR: It was a clear intent to place the  
19 United States directly under the United Nations and to  
20 scrap our constitution.

21 The universal peace is the prerequisite for  
22 the pursuit of that goal. And from the competitive  
23 anarchy of national states that, therefore, the age of  
24 nations must end, and the era of humanity must begin.

25



1                    "...THEREFORE, THE AGE OF NATIONS MUST END,  
2                    AND THE ERA OF HUMANITY BEGIN..."

3                    NARRATOR: You'll find there's a constant call  
4                    for the merging of all humanity. Here's a resolution  
5                    adopted in the United Nations. This is what it says:  
6                    Regulation, limitation and balanced reduction of all  
7                    armed forces and all armaments.

8  
9                    "REGULATION, LIMITATION AND BALANCED REDUCTION  
10                    OF ALL ARMED FORCES AND ALL ARMAMENTS."

11                    NARRATOR: The "all armaments" means your  
12                    weapons that you have in your closet for your own  
13                    defense. It includes handguns and rifles and all kinds  
14                    of things.

15                    Here's your blueprint for world peace, which  
16                    was issued also in 1961, concurrently as this move  
17                    towards putting us under the United Nations.

18                    You'll find that as the United States and  
19                    Russian military are to be reduced, the UN is  
20                    consistently brought up to a higher and higher position.  
21                    The only thing we are left with are internal security  
22                    forces.

23                    Under the Freedom From War, this is a packet  
24                    issued by the federal government to go along with  
25                    87-297. This can only be achieved, the merging and

1    disarmament, through the progressive strengthening of  
2    international institutions under the United Nations and  
3    by creating a United Nations peace force.

4

5                   "PEACE CAN ONLY BE ACHIEVED...PROGRESSIVE  
6    STRENGTHENING OF INTERNATIONAL INSTITUTIONS UNDER THE  
7    UNITED NATIONS."

7

8                   NARRATOR: See, they want to progressively  
9    strengthen the international institutions, all of which  
10   come under the United Nations.

11                   We are to lose our sovereignty. This can only  
12   be achieved through the progressive strengthening.

13

14                   "BY CREATING A UNITED NATIONS PEACE (POLICE)  
15    FORCE TO ENFORCE THE PEACE."

15

16                   NARRATOR: By creating a United Nations peace,  
17   which really means police, force to enforce the peace.

18                   This is what Daniel said:

19                   "And by peace the Antichrist shall destroy  
20   many. He shall also stand up against the Prince of  
21   princes; but he shall be broken without hand.

22                   "And it was given unto him to make war with  
23   the saints, and to overcome them; and power was given  
24   him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.

25                   "And all that dwell upon the earth shall

1 worship him, whose names are not written in the book of  
2 life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the  
3 world."

4 All right. Back to the government report.  
5 The disbanding of all national armed forces and the  
6 prohibition of their re-establishment in any form  
7 whatsoever, other than those required to preserve  
8 internal order and for contributions to a United Nations  
9 peace force.

10 They are bringing the UN up to a point where  
11 no state would have the military power to challenge the  
12 progressively strengthened U.S. peace force. And all  
13 the international disputes would be settled according to  
14 the agreed principles of international conduct. That's  
15 exactly what the Bible says:

16 "It was given unto him to make war with the  
17 saints, and to overcome them; and power was given him  
18 over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations."

19 No one can make war with this final world  
20 entity. And if you will study your scriptures, you will  
21 find that the United Nations fulfills every parameter  
22 listed for the Antichrist system.

23 And Public Law 87-297 has been updated. There  
24 are numerous updates. If you go search them out, Public  
25 Law 101216, for example, has been updated. Here's

1 another one:

2 I have today signed H.R. 1495, the "Arms  
3 Control and Disarmament Amends Act of 1989." It  
4 authorizes the fiscal appropriations to get this  
5 underway.

6 Now, the problem with it is the Bill of Rights  
7 Amendment 2, the right to bear arms, a well-regulated  
8 militia being necessary for the security of a free  
9 state, the right of the people to keep and bear arms  
10 shall not be infringed.

11 In reality, you cannot infringe that right in  
12 any way, method or manner. The only way a people can  
13 remain free is to hold in their power the weapons  
14 necessary to secure their free state.

15 This amendment deals with the international  
16 security of the United States from its own government.  
17 In other words, this amendment was to secure the  
18 people's freedom from their own government, from an  
19 internal government takeover.

20 This right is not there so that you can go  
21 hunting or for the other excuses made. It is there to  
22 prevent the government of the United States from  
23 becoming a dictatorship by treason. In other words, by  
24 betrayal of the Constitution of the United States.

25 Now, in order to merge the United States into

1 the United Nations requires a total betrayal of the  
2 constitution which guarantees you a free state through  
3 the right to bear arms.

4

5 "THE UNITED NATIONS IS A COMMUNIST,  
6 ILLUMINIST, MASONIC WORLD DICTATORSHIP WITH NO FREEDOMS,  
7 HENCE THEY MUST GET THE GUNS TO ELIMINATE OUR FREE  
8 STATE/NATION."

7

8 NARRATOR: Do you see the connection? The  
9 United Nations is a communist, illuminist, masonic world  
10 dictatorship, and there are no freedoms, hence they have  
11 to get the guns to eliminate the free state/nation  
12 guarantee in our constitution.

13 The Iron Mountain report then is a report in  
14 reality on how to circumvent the constitution of the  
15 United States. And in reality, it's a document of  
16 treason of how the rich men of the earth are actually  
17 going to divert the attentions of the people away so  
18 they can get this done.

19 The guidelines given by the government for the  
20 Iron Mountain report:

21 EMPLOYMENT

- 22 1. MILITARY STYLE OBJECTIVITY.  
23 2. AVOIDANCE OF VALUE ASSUMPTIONS.  
24 3. INCLUSION OF ALL RELEVANT DATA.

24 NARRATOR: And this is a very important part  
25 of this report is the avoidance of all value

1 assumptions. This is what makes it so absolutely cold  
2 and inhuman. It is to be amoral as a computer is  
3 amoral. It deals in factual data. There is not any  
4 mercy. There is not any compassion. It doesn't deal in  
5 right or wrong or what is good or evil.

6           It is a report on the handling of men, women,  
7 children and babies on the basis of herd or animal  
8 management without regard to any moral considerations  
9 whatsoever.

10           It reduces people to objects. It reduces all  
11 humans to nonentities with no rights of  
12 self-determination, with no rights granted by the  
13 creator, and with absolutely no rights under a  
14 constitution. The Constitution has been effectively  
15 canceled by Iron Mountain.

16           Now, again, you'll find these resolutions  
17 coming up in Congress all the time that want to  
18 strengthen the United Nations to establish an  
19 international criminal court, S.J. 32.

20           These are bills that are before the Congress  
21 and the Senate, the implementation of Agenda 21 and  
22 other agreements, which is all United Nations. Reagan  
23 called for the world army. Clinton has approved a UN  
24 army. You're seeing it on TV all the time.

25

1 "PART ONE: WAR IS REQUIRED, THE GLUE OF NATIONS."

2

3 NARRATOR: War is required, the glue of the  
4 nations, according to the Iron Mountain report. Is war  
5 the scourge of the nations?

6 It is said that war is merely an extension of  
7 diplomacy by other means. It is also said that war is  
8 necessary waste.

9 But what is war and why do peoples of the  
10 earth continuously fight and die? Why do millions of  
11 human families have a member or members that they have  
12 lost to this thing called war? What is the reality  
13 behind war? Does man have to fight wars, or can he  
14 develop a system of peace? And would the development of  
15 peace be worse than war itself?

16 The Bible gives us some answers. The rest can  
17 be supplied by simple logic and deduction.

18 James tells us that: "From whence come wars  
19 and fightings among you, come they not hence even of  
20 your lust that war on your members.

21 "He lust and have not. He kill and desire to  
22 have, and he cannot obtain. He fight in war, yet he  
23 have not because you asked not.

24 "He ask and receive not because you ask amiss,  
25 that you may consume it upon your lust. The root of war

1 then is lust, and lust is want. And want is greed. And  
2 the root of greed is a self-centered heart and  
3 unregenerated human heart."

4 This is the key we need to explain war. And  
5 the Bible gives us many clues to why warfare is, and  
6 that in reality it can never be stopped.

7 The root of the problem lies with the human  
8 heart. And the Bible says that the human heart is so  
9 desperately wicked that none can know it.

10 Jeremiah says that: "The heart is deceitful  
11 above all things who can know it."

12 Paul says in Romans: "Their carnal mind is  
13 enmity against God, for it is not subject to the laws of  
14 God neither indeed can be."

15 Jesus was very emphatic that: "Out of the  
16 heart of man put forth all kinds of evil. The problem  
17 with mankind is then his evil heart, even because it is  
18 self-centered and evil because it does not contain true  
19 love. The love within that it does have is hurtful or  
20 harmful, manipulative, self-centered and filled with his  
21 own desires," according to the Lord.

22 But we obtain other clues as well from the  
23 scripture as to the true reasons for war. In  
24 particularly our day and age James says:

25 "Go to now ye rich men. Weep and howl for the



1 miseries that shall come upon you. Your riches are  
2 corrupted, and your garments are moth-eaten.

3 "Your gold and your silver is cankered. The  
4 rest of them shall be a witness against you and shall  
5 eat your flesh as it were fire. He have heaped together  
6 treasure for the last days. He have killed and  
7 condemned the just."

8 Now, let's run a little logic. Lust is the  
9 center of war. Lust is greed. And greed is from evil,  
10 self-centered hearts. The Bible says that:

11 "The love of money is the root of all evil or  
12 the height of all greeds. Lust then is greed, and the  
13 ultimate greed is an insane love of money, which brings  
14 with it power, which brings with it control over  
15 mankind. Thus, the rich men of the earth earn deed and  
16 total control over money."

17 And they have developed a system of economic  
18 controls well laid out from the scriptures. If the rich  
19 men of the earth gain control over the planet via their  
20 Babylonian economic system, then they are the ones who  
21 are only powerful enough and rich enough to wage war,  
22 and they are the only ones who can develop the war  
23 machines that you are looking at on your television  
24 screen. They are the ones who can develop the weapons  
25 necessary for modern warfare.

1           Iron Mountain agrees the very title confirms  
2 the Bible. The title says that it is a report and that  
3 it is a desirability and feasibility for peace. It was  
4 ordered by the rich men of the earth; therefore, they  
5 themselves must be the ones waging the wars.

6           And now they have elected not to wage wars but  
7 have elected to do something else, because warfare is  
8 drawing to a close. It will have soon served its  
9 purpose. In other words, it is a deliberate effort to  
10 bring in another system, for the first system of war has  
11 almost accomplished the goals originally intended.

12           Albert Pike was purported to have written a  
13 letter in which he outlines three world wars. Each had  
14 a specific purpose and each had a goal. The last war,  
15 World War III, was to be fought to bring in an era of  
16 peace under Lucifer. It was to be fought predominantly  
17 between the United States and the Soviet Union, and it  
18 would come in an era of seeming peace when it seemed  
19 like everything was fine, everything was great.

20           The Bible says that: "The Antichrist is a man  
21 of peace. He rides a white horse and has no war  
22 machine. There are no arrows in his bow. He is to  
23 usher in a period of peace after great wars."

24           Iron Mountain is about this era of peace.  
25 Iron Mountain is a report to aid Antichrist in his rise

1 to power. It is, in reality, a report from hell.

2

3 "WHAT CAN BE EXPECTED IF PEACE COMES? WHAT  
4 SHOULD WE BE PREPARED TO DO ABOUT IT? WHAT, FOR  
5 INSTANCE, ARE THE REAL FUNCTIONS OF WAR IN MODERN  
6 SOCIETIES..."

5

6 NARRATOR: Iron Mountain asks, what can be  
7 expected if peace comes? What should we be prepared to  
8 do about it? What, for instance, are the real functions  
9 of war in modern societies?

10 These are very important questions. The  
11 Soviet Union says: The peaceful exploration of outer  
12 space is the constructive alternative to the plans aimed  
13 at spreading the arms race.

14 In other words, we're going to find that the  
15 opposite of war is peace which, of course, it is in  
16 reality. But what Iron Mountain is getting at is what  
17 are the real functions of warfare, the invisible  
18 functions of warfare. What role do they play in the  
19 overall structure of human society?

20 For example, the Soviet Union has been on a  
21 war footing for years and years. We have, to a lesser  
22 extent in America, been on a war footing. It's been  
23 predominantly a cold war for many, many years. But  
24 nonetheless, it has been as far as the economics of it  
25 are concerned, it has been a war era. It's been an age

1 of war. And what this report is asking about is what  
2 about peace.

3

4 "IT IS SURELY NO EXAGGERATION TO SAY THAT  
5 CONDITIONS OF WORLD PEACE WOULD LEAD TO CHANGES IN THE  
6 SOCIAL STRUCTURES OF THE NATIONS...."

6

7 NARRATOR: It is surely no exaggeration to say  
8 the conditions of world peace would lead to changes in  
9 the social structures of the nations.

10

11 "THESE CHANGES WOULD BE OF...UNPARALLELED AND  
12 REVOLUTIONARY MAGNITUDE."

12

13 NARRATOR: These changes would be of  
14 unparalleled and revolutionary magnitude.

15 As we would transition then from an era of war  
16 into peace, what would be the problems?

17

18 "IT IS THE INCORRECT ASSUMPTION THAT WAR AS AN  
19 INSTITUTION IS SUBORDINATE TO THE SOCIAL SYSTEM IT IS  
20 BELIEVED TO SERVE."

20

21 NARRATOR: It is an incorrect assumption that  
22 war as an institution is subordinate to the social  
23 system it is believed to serve.

24 What they're saying here is that nations wage  
25 war for reasons other than what they state.

1

2 "WAR ITSELF IS THE BASIC SOCIAL SYSTEM, WITHIN  
3 WHICH OTHERS ARE SECONDARY MODES OF ORGANIZATION,  
4 CONFLICT OR CONSPIRE."

4

5 NARRATOR: War is the basic social system,  
6 within which others are secondary modes of organization,  
7 conflict or conspire.

8 In other words, war itself is the basic social  
9 system of mankind. And if we go to peace, we're going  
10 to have problems unless we understand that.

11

12 "IT IS THE SYSTEM WHICH HAS GOVERNED MOST  
13 HUMAN SOCIETIES OF RECORD, AS IT IS TODAY."

13

14 NARRATOR: It is the system which has governed  
15 most human societies on record today.

16 Well, this is, of course, very true in our day  
17 and age. We have seen nothing but war starting with  
18 predominantly World War I and then coming forward. The  
19 Soviet Union has had tremendous expenditures in their  
20 military, and the United States has likewise. It's  
21 been, in reality, an ages race. We're going to find out  
22 there's a reason for it.

23

24 "THE CAPACITY OF A NATION TO MAKE WAR IS THE  
25 GREATEST SOCIAL POWER IT CAN EXERCISE; WAR MAKING,  
ACTIVE OR CONTEMPLATED, IS A MATTER OF LIFE AND  
DEATH...."

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NARRATOR: The capacity of a nation to make war is the greatest social power it can exercise; war making, active or contemplated, is a matter of life and death, says Iron Mountain.

"THE MISCONCEPTIONS OF WAR: TO DEFEND A NATION FROM MILITARY ATTACK BY ANOTHER, OR TO DETER SUCH ATTACK;...."

NARRATOR: The misconceptions of war. One, to defend a nation from military attack by another or to deter such attack.

"THE MISCONCEPTIONS OF WAR...TO DEFEND THE NATIONAL INTEREST - ECONOMIC, POLITICAL, IDEOLOGICAL;"

NARRATOR: To defend the national interest - economic, political or ideological.

"THE MISCONCEPTIONS OF WAR...TO MAINTAIN OR INCREASE A NATION'S MILITARY POWER FOR ITS OWN SAKE."

NARRATOR: To maintain or increase a nation's military power for its own sake.

"THESE ARE THE VISIBLE, OSTENSIBLE FUNCTIONS OF WAR. BUT THERE ARE OTHER BROADER, MORE PROFOUNDLY FELT FUNCTIONS OF WAR."

1

2           NARRATOR: Now, see, these are the visible or  
3 more obvious reasons why a person would say, well,  
4 that's why we have war. But what they're saying is  
5 there are more less obvious, very invisible reasons for  
6 why nations have war, and this is the heart of the  
7 entire Iron Mountain report.

8           Its conclusion was that war is absolutely  
9 necessary. It's an absolute requirement for human  
10 societies and nations to come together. It is, in  
11 reality, they claim, the glue of the nations.

12           The Soviet military machine, or its war-making  
13 capacity, is the actual glue that has held the Soviet  
14 Union and the communist empire together. If they were  
15 to move into an era of peace, what would happen?

16

17           "IT IS THESE INVISIBLE, OR IMPLIED, FUNCTIONS  
18 THAT...ARE THE DOMINANT FORCES IN OUR SOCIETIES. WHAT  
19 ARE THEY?"

19

20           NARRATOR: All right. Iron Mountain says: It  
21 is these implied functions that are the dominant forces  
22 in our society.

23           So what we have to find out then is what are  
24 the true functions of war in a society. Why, for  
25 example, has the Soviet Union and the United States,

1 both of which are controlled by the rich men of the  
2 earth, been on a constant war footing constantly  
3 escalating this conflict? Why are they doing it and  
4 what are their reasons behind it?

5 Economic reasons are:

6

7 "ECONOMIC NECESSARY WASTE, IT OPERATES OUTSIDE  
8 THE NORMAL ECONOMIC SUPPLY AND DEMAND SYSTEM. IT  
9 CREATES ARTIFICIAL DEMAND."

9

10 NARRATOR: It is the necessary waste that  
11 operates outside the normal economic supply and demand  
12 system. Warfare creates an artificial demand. The war  
13 system having huge militaries, with all of their  
14 armaments, with all the research and development,  
15 creates a demand.

16

17 "ECONOMIC. THIS WASTE OF MONEY OUTSIDE THE  
18 SYSTEM ACTS AS A COUNTER-BALANCE FORCE TO THE OVERALL  
19 ECONOMY."

19

20 NARRATOR: This waste of money outside the  
21 system, according to Iron Mountain, acts as a  
22 counter-balance to the economic growth of the nation.

23

24 "ECONOMIC. IT IS PROGRESSIVELY FOR RESEARCH  
25 AND DEVELOPMENT OF WEAPONS SYSTEMS, SPURRING  
TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCES."



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NARRATOR: It is progressively for research and development of weapons systems, and it spurs technological expenses which spin off and help society at large.

"DEFENSE SPENDING PER SE MIGHT BE COUNTENANCED ECONOMIC GROUNDS ALONE AS A STIMULATOR OF THE NATIONAL METABOLISM...."

NARRATOR: Defense spending per se might be countenanced economic grounds alone as a stimulator of the national metabolism.

In other words, war itself for economic purposes is a tremendous growth factor.

"POLITICAL. A NATION IS A GROUP OF PEOPLE ORGANIZED TOGETHER WITH A COMMON GOAL AND A NATIONAL IDENTITY."

NARRATOR: For the political reasons it's different. A nation is a group of people organized together with a common goal and a national identity.

"POLITICAL. THE NATION HAS AN OUTLOOK/ATTITUDE OF HOW IT WILL DEAL WITH OTHER NATIONS. WE CALL IT FOREIGN POLICY."

1                   NARRATOR: The nation has an outlook or an  
2 attitude of how it will deal with other nations. And  
3 that's what we call foreign policy.

4

5                   "...A NATION'S FOREIGN POLICY CAN HAVE NO  
6 SUBSTANCE IF IT LACKS THE MEANS OF ENFORCING ITS  
7 ATTITUDE ON OTHER NATIONS."

7

8                   NARRATOR: A nation's foreign policy, says  
9 Iron Mountain, can have no substitute if it lacks the  
10 means of enforcing its attitude.

11                  In other words, if the nation is not strong  
12 enough, it doesn't matter what their attitude towards  
13 somebody else is.

14

15                  "WAR...IS ITSELF THE DEFINING ELEMENT OF ANY  
16 NATION'S EXISTENCE VIS-A-VIS ANY OTHER NATION. WAR  
17 EQUALS NATIONS. PEACE EQUALS NO NATIONS."

17

18                  NARRATOR: War is itself the defining element  
19 of any nation's existence vis-a-vis any other nation.  
20 War then equals nations because it is the glue of  
21 nations and what causes them to come together. And  
22 peace would mean the dissolving of the nations.

23                  "THE ELIMINATION OF WAR IMPLIES THE INEVITABLE  
24 ELIMINATION OF NATIONAL SOVEREIGNTY AND THE TRADITIONAL  
25 NATION-STATE."

25

1           NARRATOR: The elimination of war implies the  
2 elimination of national sovereignty and the traditional  
3 nation-state.

4           Please understand the importance of that  
5 remark in Iron Mountain. It is the elimination of war  
6 that brings us to world government.

7

8           "THE WAR SYSTEM NOT ONLY HAS BEEN ESSENTIAL TO  
9 THE EXISTENCE OF NATIONS AS INDEPENDENT POLITICAL  
10 ENTITIES, BUT HAS BEEN EQUALLY INDISPENSABLE TO THEIR  
11 STABLE INTERNAL POLITICAL STRUCTURE."

12           NARRATOR: The war system not only has been  
13 essential to the existence of nations as independent  
14 political entities, but has been equally indispensable  
15 to their stable internal development.

16

17           "WITHOUT IT (THE WAR SYSTEM), NO GOVERNMENT  
18 HAS EVER BEEN ABLE TO OBTAIN ACQUIESCENCE IN ITS  
19 LEGITIMACY, OR RIGHT TO RULE ITS SOCIETY."

20

21           NARRATOR: Without it (the war system), no  
22 government has ever been able to obtain its legitimacy.

23           In other words, we could say its right to rule  
24 its society. War is the basis of that claim to rule.  
25 And it is, therefore, the glue that holds a nation  
together, according to Iron Mountain.

26

1                   "THE POSSIBILITY OF WAR PROVIDES THE SENSE OF  
EXTERNAL NECESSITY WITHOUT WHICH NO GOVERNMENT CAN  
2                   REMAIN IN POWER."

3

4                   NARRATOR: The possibility of war provides the  
5                   sense of external necessity without which no government  
6                   can remain in power.

7

8                   "THE ORGANIZATION OF A SOCIETY FOR THE  
POSSIBILITY OF WAR IS ITS PRINCIPAL POLITICAL  
9                   STABILIZER."

10

11                  NARRATOR: The organization of a society for  
12                  the possibility of war it its principal political  
13                  stabilizer.

14                  All right. In other words, for the Soviet  
15                  Union, they said that the American people were the  
16                  enemy. And that gave them the glue which held the  
17                  Soviet empire together, which rallied the people to make  
18                  such sacrifices so that we could build up this huge war  
19                  machine.

20

21                  "THE BASIC AUTHORITY OF THE MODERN STATE OVER  
22                  ITS PEOPLE RESIDES IN ITS WAR POWERS."

23

24

25

1           NARRATOR: The basic authority of the modern  
2 state over its people resides in its war powers. Now,  
3 that's another very important statement.

4

5           "THEFORE, A SUBSTITUTE FOR THE WAR SYSTEM  
6 MUST BE FOUND IN ORDER TO CONTROL THE PEOPLE AND PROVIDE  
7 STABILITY AND LEGITIMACY OF GOVERNMENT."

7

8           NARRATOR: Therefore, a substitute for the war  
9 system must be found in order to control the people and  
10 provide stability and legitimacy of government, if we go  
11 into an era of peace.

12           Now, we know that the United Nations is to be  
13 that era of peace. So, therefore, what they are saying  
14 is we have to find substitutes for what war does, the  
15 invisible functions of war. We have to find the  
16 substitute for that if we are going to go to peace.

17

18           "OBVIOUSLY, IF THE WAR MACHINE IS DISCARDED,  
19 NEW POLITICAL MACHINERY WOULD BE NEEDED AT ONCE."

19

20           NARRATOR: Obviously, if the war machine is  
21 discarded, new political machinery would be needed at  
22 once.

23           In other words, as they phase war out, they  
24 have to phase whatever they're going to put in its place  
25 in to control the people, to control the nation. This

1 is an essential part of Iron Mountain.

2

3 "UNTIL IT (THE SUBSTITUTE FOR WAR) IS  
4 DEVELOPED, THE CONTINUANCE OF THE WAR SYSTEM MUST BE  
5 ASSURED...TO MAINTAIN THE STABILITY OF ITS INTERNAL  
6 ORGANIZATION OF POWER."

5

6 NARRATOR: Until it (the substitute for war)  
7 is developed, the continuance of the war system must be  
8 assured to maintain the stability of its internal  
9 organization of power. In other words, we have to keep  
10 the war system going in order to remain in control.

11

12 "INTERPRETATION: KEEP WAR UNTIL ALL  
13 SUBSTITUTES ARE IN PLACE AND RUNNING, SO WE DON'T LOSE  
14 OUR RULERSHIP."

14

15 NARRATOR: Keep war until all substitutes are  
16 in place and running, so we don't lose our rulership.

17 In other words, those that are in power are  
18 going to remain in power. They've got to figure out a  
19 way to do that so they're going to de-escalate the war  
20 system as they bring in a peace system. And the peace  
21 system is going to radically alter our societies.

22

23 "WHAT SUBSTITUTES FOR WAR ARE THERE? IRON  
24 MOUNTAIN OFFERED SEVERAL SUBSTITUTES."

24

25 NARRATOR: What substitutes for war are there?

1 "IT MUST BE A UNIVERSAL THREAT OF EQUAL  
2 MAGNITUDE AS THAT OF WORLD WAR."

3 NARRATOR: Well, it has to be a universal  
4 threat of equal magnitude as that of world war. The  
5 immediate loss of life and the immediate thought that  
6 blood is going to be shed.

7  
8 "IT MUST BE CREDIBLE; IT MUST BE ACCEPTED BY  
9 THE VAST MAJORITY OF THE POPULATION."

10 NARRATOR: It has to be credible, and it must  
11 be accepted by the vast majority of the population of  
12 any given nation or, in reality, the whole world if  
13 they're going to bring in global peace.

14  
15 "CREDIBILITY, IN FACT, LIES AT THE HEART OF  
16 THE PROBLEM OF DEVELOPING A POLITICAL SUBSTITUTE FOR  
17 WAR."

18 NARRATOR: Credibility, in fact, says Iron  
19 Mountain, lies at the heart of the problem of developing  
20 a political substitute for war.

21  
22 "WE MUST EMPHASIZE THAT ONE MUST BE FOUND, OF  
23 CREDIBLE QUALITY AND MAGNITUDE, IF A TRANSITION TO PEACE  
24 IS EVER TO COME ABOUT WITHOUT SOCIAL DISINTEGRATION."

25 NARRATOR: We must emphasize that one must be

1 found, of credible quality and magnitude, if a  
2 transition to peace is ever to come about without social  
3 disintegration.

4           In other words, really what they're saying is  
5 a nation would self-destruct without an external threat  
6 of some type.

7

8           "IT IS MORE PROBABLE, IN OUR JUDGMENT, THAT  
9 SUCH A THREAT WILL HAVE TO BE INVENTED, RATHER THAN  
10 DEVELOPED FROM SOME UNKNOWN CONDITIONS."

10

11           NARRATOR: It is more probable, in our  
12 judgment, that such a threat will have to be invented,  
13 rather than developed from some unknown conditions.  
14 That means exactly what it says. They're going to  
15 invent a system to accomplish this.

16           Ecology, pollution.

17

18           "...AN EFFECTIVE POLITICAL SUBSTITUTE FOR WAR  
19 WOULD REQUIRE ALTERNATE ENEMIES..."

19

20           NARRATOR: An effective political substitute  
21 for war would require alternate enemies. In other  
22 words, we have to find an external threat that's  
23 essentially very large.

24

25



1 "IT MAY BE, FOR INSTANCE, THAT GROSS POLLUTION  
2 OF THE ENVIRONMENT CAN EVENTUALLY REPLACE THE  
3 POSSIBILITY OF MASS DESTRUCTION BY NUCLEAR WEAPONS AS  
4 THE PRINCIPLE THREAT TO THE SURVIVAL OF THE SPECIES."

4 NARRATOR: It may be, for instance, that gross  
5 pollution of the environment can eventually replace the  
6 possibility of mass destruction by nuclear weapons as  
7 the principle threat to the survival of the species.

8 In other words, they're going to bring the  
9 environment up to a point of global threat. Poisoning  
10 of the air and other principle sources of the food and  
11 water supply is already well-advanced. And at first  
12 glance, which seem promising in this respect, it  
13 constitutes a threat that can be dealt with only through  
14 a social organization and political power.

15

16 "BUT FROM PRESENT INDICATIONS IT WILL BE A  
17 GENERATION TO A GENERATION AND A HALF BEFORE  
18 ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTION...WILL BE SUFFICIENTLY MENACING  
19 ON A GLOBAL SCALE TO OFFER...A SOLUTION."

19 NARRATOR: But from present indications it  
20 will be a generation to a generation and a half before  
21 environmental pollution will be sufficiently menacing on  
22 a global scale to offer a solution as a substitute for  
23 war.

24 In other words, we replace the war threat with  
25 an environmental threat. Now you know why the

1 environment is on the TVs and the media constantly.

2

3 "GENERATION EQUALS 30 YEARS.  
4 1961 + 30 = 1991."

4

5 NARRATOR: A generation is about 30 years, so  
6 it would be about 1991 that this would be brought up to  
7 global scale. It is true that the rate of pollution  
8 could be increased selectively for this purpose. In  
9 other words, you could selectively find areas where you  
10 could deliberately increase the pollution to get this  
11 threat in motion a little quicker.

12

13 "IT IS TRUE THAT THE RATE OF POLLUTION COULD  
14 BE INCREASED SELECTIVELY FOR THIS PURPOSE...."

14

15 NARRATOR: It is true that the rate of  
16 pollution can be increased selectively.

17

18 "IN FACT, THE MERE MODIFYING OF EXISTING  
19 PROGRAMS FOR THE DETERRENCE OF POLLUTION COULD SPEED UP  
20 THE PROCESS ENOUGH TO MAKE THE THREAT CREDIBLE MUCH  
21 SOONER."

20

21 NARRATOR: In fact, the mere modifying of  
22 existing programs for the deterrence of pollution could  
23 speed up the process enough to make the threat credible  
24 much sooner.

25

In other words, let's have the governments

1 drag their feet on pollution controls or the enforcement  
2 of pollution controls. And around the world, that's  
3 exactly what we are seeing, a matter of foot-dragging on  
4 the areas. One would then, perhaps, get the concept  
5 that this was all deliberate.

6

7 "TRANSLATION: ALLOW POLLUTION TO DELIBERATELY  
8 GET WORSE UNTIL IT CAN BE MANIPULATED BY THE CONTROLLED  
9 MEDIA INTO A WORLD CRISIS."

9

10 NARRATOR: Allow pollution to deliberately get  
11 worse until it can be manipulated by the controlled  
12 media into a world crisis. A global crisis has to be  
13 developed.

14 Al Gore, Vice President, a very timely book,  
15 perhaps coincidentally, he wrote the book "Ecology and  
16 the Human Spirit." It's a modern version of Iron  
17 Mountain in the ecological field. And in reality, it's  
18 quite an interesting book. You should go out and buy a  
19 copy of it.

20 The new world government organizations are  
21 pushing this climate. Emergency earth rescue  
22 administration, the people of the earth have a new  
23 common enemy which requires an emergency worldwide  
24 campaign. You see, we have to abandon our armaments to  
25 join in a common cause for survival.

1                   "THE PEOPLE OF THE EARTH HAVE A NEW COMMON  
2 ENEMY...IRON MOUNTAIN...THREAT TO THE SURVIVAL OF THE  
3 SPECIES..."

3

4                   NARRATOR:  What did Iron Mountain say?  That  
5 it had to be a threat to the survival of the species.

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1 "ARCTIC OZONE EXPEDITION"

2 (FILM)

3

4 NARRATOR #2: It wasn't until the late 1960s  
5 when the Apollo missions were bound for the moon that we  
6 were first able to see complete pictures of the earth.

7 Environmentalists began to look at our planet  
8 as a simple, fragile ecosystem. Now we are intensely  
9 sighting the thin halo of atmosphere that surrounds and  
10 protects earth.

11 It recycles the air we breathe, regulates the  
12 climate and acts as a protective barrier filtering out  
13 much of the sun's harmful radiation.

14 Last year an international group of scientists  
15 proved that ozone, the key element in this filtering  
16 process, is being lost at an alarming rate in the South  
17 Pole. In fact, a sizeable hole develops over this area  
18 each winter. Without ozone, the sun's harmful radiation  
19 will destroy life on earth.

20 A group of manmade compounds called  
21 chlorofluorocarbons or CFCs used as refrigerants,  
22 cleaning solvents, and some plastic foams are to blame  
23 for this environmental problem. They eventually make  
24 their way into the atmosphere and destroy ozone.

25 According to Dr. Brian Tool (phonetic) of

1 NASA's Ames Research Center, it is a global scale  
2 environmental problem.

3 \* \* \* \*

4 DR. TOOL: (Phonetic spelling) It's really the  
5 first time in the history of environmental science where  
6 human beings on one side of the planet have done  
7 something to the planet that has significantly affected  
8 it globally, and on the far side of the planet from  
9 where the original pollution took place.

10 \* \* \* \*

11 NARRATOR #2: Using the beautiful seaport town  
12 of Stavanger, Norway as a base of operations, an  
13 international team of scientists assembled this year in  
14 an emergency effort to make a detailed study of the  
15 North Pole. Most of the work was performed aboard two  
16 NASA aircraft.

17 This is the ER-2. For the mission, special  
18 wing pods are attached containing atmospheric chemistry  
19 analysis and a host of other instruments. Typically,  
20 flights are made about 12 miles out along the fringes of  
21 space right into the layers of atmosphere directly  
22 affected by ozone loss.

23 The ER-2 research buttoner (phonetic) is a  
24 modified EC-8. It flies at lower altitudes, but has  
25 increased fuel reserves which allow it to cover more

1 territory, even flights directly over the North Pole.

2           Inside the EC-8 is actually a scientific  
3 observatory loaded with certain instruments. Scientists  
4 perform their experiments and are able to map results  
5 right on the spot.

6           This instrument contains four lasers capable  
7 of shooting light many miles up into the atmosphere.  
8 The light reflects back to the plane and provides  
9 scientists with a cross-sectional map of ozone  
10 concentrations, as well as aerosols or regions where  
11 ozone is capable of occurring.

12           Initial results from both aircraft indicate  
13 that high concentrations of CFCs have been found in  
14 northern latitudes primed for ozone destruction. When  
15 combined with high-altitude ice clouds, the right amount  
16 of sunlight and confined slow-moving masses of air,  
17 ozone destruction occurs.

18           As a result of this airborne mission,  
19 scientists were able to confirm the process and predict  
20 areas of danger. International policymakers have met in  
21 hopes of limiting the amount of CFC production, and  
22 recently agreed to phase out its use by the year 2000.  
23 Many scientists worry that this may not be soon enough.  
24 Again, Dr. Tool (phonetic).

25

\* \* \* \*

1 DR. TOOL: (Phonetic spelling) The ozone  
2 problem, for example, when you release  
3 chlorofluorocarbons into the environment, it's decades  
4 to centuries before those are removed.

5 \* \* \* \*

6 NARRATOR #2: Researching safe economic  
7 replacements for CFCs is a vital part of solving this  
8 serious environmental issue. Thanks to the intensive  
9 work done in the last few years, we know why ozone  
10 depletion exists. It is now up to the world community  
11 to take responsibility for the future of our global  
12 environment.

13

14 "IT IS NOW UP TO THE WORLD COMMUNITY TO TAKE  
15 RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE FUTURE OF OUR GLOBAL  
16 ENVIRONMENT."

16

17 NARRATOR #2: Two Landsat satellites continue  
18 to orbit the earth 14 times a day. From their  
19 570-mile-high vantage point, they return images like  
20 these taken over rich California farmlands. Telltale  
21 images indicate vigorous vegetation growth. The state  
22 of California is using land SAT imagery to inventory and  
23 map its irrigated cropland.

24

25 \* \* \* \*



1                   NARRATOR #3: Ecology, the balance of nature,  
2 is important to all life. One of the tools we can use  
3 to monitor this balance of nature on earth is the  
4 satellite. Satellites can be used to observe our planet  
5 from a high vantage point. A NASA film called "Remote  
6 Possibilities" tells us the story:

7   \* \* \* \*

8   (SHORT FILM WITH NARRATION)

9                   From far out in space, the earth appears  
10 serene and beautiful displaying no hint of our crowded  
11 planet's many problems. As we have used and changed our  
12 planet, we have become aware that in many ways we are  
13 exhausting it; exhausting our food supplies, our sources  
14 of energy, our natural lands, exhausting the potential  
15 of even the one seemingly limitless oceans.

16                   Management of earth's resources is at a  
17 critical stage. It has never been more important that  
18 we understand the environmental relationships of our  
19 planet. Scientists are striving to apply the technology  
20 of the Space Age, the quest for more and better  
21 information about these complex relationships.

22   (END OF SHORT FILM)

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24                   "THE IRON MOUNTAIN RECOMMENDATION THAT THE  
25 ENVIRONMENT BE MADE A GLOBAL THREAT HAS BEEN  
ACCOMPLISHED."

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NARRATOR #3: In 1972 a new kind of satellite  
left the launch pad and rose to an altitude of 910  
kilometers from earth. There it settled in a circular  
orbit around the planet. This satellite called land SAT  
opened a new era of earth resource management.

(END OF FILM)

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(IRON MOUNTAIN REPORT RESUMES)

"ONE SUBSTITUTE FOR WAR HAS NOW BEEN FOUND.  
THE IRON MOUNTAIN AGENDA IS BEING CARRIED OUT."

NARRATOR: One substitute for war has now been  
found. The Iron Mountain agenda is being carried out.

"THE OBJECTIVE OF THE ECO-SCAM.  
1. UN CONTROL OVER ALL LAND.  
2. OWNERSHIP OF THE LAND TO BE HELD BY THE  
'RICH MEN'."

NARRATOR: The objectives of the eco-scam.  
Well, the UN will end up with control over all the land,  
and ownership of the hand will be held by the rich men.

"THIS IS ARISING A CRISIS OF WORLDWIDE  
PROPORTIONS INVOLVING DEVELOPED AND DEVELOPING COUNTRIES  
ALIKE - THE CRISIS OF HUMAN ENVIRONMENT. GEORGE KENNAN,  
CFR."

NARRATOR: There is arising a crisis of  
worldwide proportions involving developed and developing  
countries alike - the crisis of the human environment.

"THE PROCESS OF COMPROMISE OF NATIONAL  
INTERESTS WILL OF COURSE HAVE TO TAKE PLACE..."

NARRATOR: The process of compromise of  
national interests will, of course, have to take place.

1                   "INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC SECURITY IS  
2                   INCONCEIVABLE UNLESS RELATED NOT ONLY TO THE WORLD'S  
3                   ENVIRONMENT, BUT ALSO TO THE ELIMINATION OF THE THREAT  
4                   TO THE WORLD'S ENVIRONMENT..."

4                                   "PRIVATE PROPERTY RIGHTS"

6                   NARRATOR: International economic security is  
7                   inconceivable unless related not only to the world's  
8                   environment, but also to the elimination of the threat  
9                   to the world's environment.

10                   Well, the only major threat is private  
11                   property ownership and private property rights where  
12                   people can do as they want.

14                   "LET US ALSO THINK ABOUT SETTING UP WITHIN THE  
15                   FRAMEWORK OF THE UNITED NATIONS A CENTER FOR EMERGENCY  
16                   ENVIRONMENTAL ASSISTANCE."

17                   NARRATOR: Let us also think about setting up  
18                   within the framework of the United Nations a center for  
19                   emergency environmental assistance.

20                   Can you see how they're raising this thing up  
21                   to an emergency status, an emergency level?

23                   "MIKHAIL GORBACHEV'S DECEMBER 8, 1989, SPEECH  
24                   AT THE UNITED NATIONS."

25

1                   NARRATOR:  And that's Mikhail Gorbachev in  
2  1989 in a speech to the United Nations.

3

4                   "THE UNITED NATIONS WILL BE THE CONTROLLER OF  
5  ALL LANDS IN THE WORLD."

6

6                   NARRATOR:  The United Nations will be the  
7  controller of all the lands in the world through their  
8  various ecological environmental organizations that they  
9  are in the process of setting up.

10                  In fact, the Rio Earth Summit was for that  
11  specific reason.

12

13                  "THE UNITED NATIONS WAS SET UP BY THE 'RICH  
14  MEN', IT IS THEIR FRONT FOR WORLD CONTROL."

14

15                  "ECO-FOUNDATIONS, WORLD WILDLIFE FUND,  
16  HERITAGE TRUST, NATURE CONSERVANCY, NATIONAL WILDLIFE  
17  FEDERATION, THE SIERRA CLUB, WORLD WILDERNESS,  
18  CONGRESS."

17

18                  NARRATOR:  Now, it's owned by the rich men.  
19  That's who owns the United Nations.  That's who actually  
20  runs it.  Eco-foundations of the World Wildlife Fund,  
21  Heritage Trust, Nature Conservancy, et cetera.

22

23                  "CONSERVATION INTERNATIONAL AND MANY UN  
24  ORGANIZATIONS.  THE 'RICH MEN' SIT ON THE BOARD OF  
25  DIRECTORS OF ALL OF THESE GROUPS."

25

1                   NARRATOR:  There's a lot of them.  And you  
2   have many UN organizations.  And the rich men of the  
3   earth sit on the boards of directors on all of these  
4   groups.

5

6                   "THESE GROUPS ARE BUYING UP HUGE CHUNKS OF  
7   PRIVATE LAND FOR 'CONSERVATION' AND TO PRESERVE 'THE  
8   EARTH' ALL OF IT OWNED BY THE 'RICH MEN'."

8

9                   NARRATOR:  These groups are buying up huge  
10  chunks of private land for conservation, they say, and  
11  to preserve the earth.  And, of course, all of it is to  
12  be owned by the rich men.

13

14                   "WHAT THEY CANNOT PURCHASE BY NORMAL MEANS  
15  WILL BE TAKEN UNDER 'ZONING' CONTROLS, DNR REGULATIONS  
16  OR OTHER LAND GRAB MEANS."

16

17                   NARRATOR:  What they cannot purchase by normal  
18  means will be taken under zoning controls, DNR  
19  regulations or other land grab means via governmental  
20  authority and regulation.

21

22                   "ALL LAND WILL BE UNDER STRICT 'ECO-CONTROLS'  
23  BECAUSE OF THE 'ECO-EMERGENCY'.  IT IS A SCAM TO CONTROL  
24  THE LAND."

24

25

1                   NARRATOR: All land will be under strict  
2 eco-controls because after all, we are now involved and  
3 in the middle of an eco-emergency, and it's nothing but  
4 a scam.

5

6                   "DEBT FOR LAND SWAP. THE INTERNATIONAL  
7 BANKERS LOAN AND CONTROL THE MONEY TO ALL COUNTRIES AND,  
8 THROUGH INTEREST, HAVE DRIVEN THEM INTO HUGE DEBT  
9 STATUS."

10

11                   NARRATOR: Debt for land swap is another part  
12 of it. The international bankers loan and control the  
13 monies to all the countries, and through interest have  
14 driven them into huge debt status. The debt of the  
15 United States is in the trillions.

16

17                   "THE BANKERS HAVE A 'NEW PLAN'. THEY WILL  
18 TAKE THE NATION'S LAND AND CANCEL THE DEBT OF THAT  
19 NATION. IT IS CALLED A DEBT FOR LAND SWAP."

20

21                   NARRATOR: The bankers then come forward with  
22 a new plan. They will take the nation's land, and then  
23 they will cancel the debt of that nation. It is called  
24 a debt for land swap.

25

26                   "THIS LAND WILL BE HELD BY A 'WORLD  
27 CONSERVATION BANK' OWNED OF COURSE BY THE 'RICH MEN OF  
28 THE EARTH'."

29

1                   NARRATOR: This land will be held by a world  
2 conservation bank owned, of course, by the rich men of  
3 the earth.

4

5                   "THEY WILL THEN OWN ALL THE LAND, ALL THE  
6 RESOURCES, ALL THE FOOD. THEY THEN BECOME THE MASTERS  
7 AND THE PEOPLE THE SLAVES."

7

8                   NARRATOR: They will then own all the land,  
9 all the resources, all the food. They become the  
10 absolute masters and all the people become the slaves.  
11 It's a perfect scam. It's a perfect system.

12

13                   "BECAUSE THE 'ECO-THREAT' IS GLOBAL. IT CAN  
14 ONLY BE CONTROLLED BY A GLOBAL AUTHORITY. THE UNITED  
15 NATIONS IS THE ONLY 'AUTHORITY'."

15

16                   NARRATOR: Because it is global, obviously it  
17 can only be controlled by a global authority. And guess  
18 who that is? Why, of course, it's the United Nations.

19                   Now, the eco-scam is being pushed by every  
20 organization that's involved in the environment. Even  
21 Time Magazine ran an article on the endangered earth.

22                   It's being put in all your children's school  
23 books, all of their study books about the crowding of  
24 human life, about how we have such an ecological crisis,  
25 an environmental crisis. And unless we all do our



1 share, the whole world is just going to disintegrate,  
2 and the entire population of man will be eliminated.  
3 That's according to them.

4           It's very interesting that Daniel said: The  
5 Antichrist, that he shall divide the land for gain.

6           In other words, he takes over all the land and  
7 divides it up amongst these various foundation groups.  
8 And that's exactly what's happening.

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"THE RIO EARTH SUMMIT"

6 IMPLEMENTED. THE GREATEST LAND GRAB IN HISTORY IS GOING  
DOWN!"

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1 "PART 2: THE SECOND 'EXTERNAL THREAT'"

2

3 NARRATOR: It has been hotly argued that such  
4 a menace would offer the last best hope for peace by  
5 uniting mankind against the danger of destruction by  
6 creatures from other planets or from outer space.

7 Experiments have been proposed to test the  
8 credibility of an out-of-our-world invasion threat. It  
9 is possible that a few of the more difficult-to-explain  
10 flying saucer incidents are of this nature.

11

12 "UNITING MANKIND AGAINST THE DANGER OF  
13 DESTRUCTION BY 'CREATURES' FROM OTHER PLANETS OR FROM  
14 OUTER SPACE."

14

15 NARRATOR: The thrust of the second threat is  
16 to unite mankind against a common enemy.

17

18 "THE ESCALATION OF THE UFO MYSTERY REQUIRES  
19 CAREFUL MEDIA CONTROL. THE THREAT MUST ALSO DOVETAIL  
20 INTO THE AGENDA FOR A ONE WORLD GOVERNMENT."

20

21 NARRATOR: The escalation of the UFO mystery  
22 requires careful media control. The threat must also  
23 dovetail into the agenda for a one world government.

24 Everything that Iron Mountain proposes and all  
25 of their substitutes will lead into a one-world

1 government.

2           And that is the whole nature of it. There has  
3 been a tremendous amount of interest in UFO activity.  
4 Many, many books have been written about it. The  
5 average Christian, I believe, probably poo-poops the  
6 whole subject.

7           But we believe here at the CIA they're making  
8 a tragic mistake when they do that, because the Bible  
9 does mention some things that would tend to imply very  
10 strongly that UFOs are, in fact, real and will be a  
11 latter day occurrence just before the end and just  
12 before the return of Jesus Christ.

13           As you can see, here's a book for Christians,  
14 "UFO End-time Dilusion." It is part of the grand  
15 dilusion that God is going to cast down upon man for the  
16 rejection of Jesus Christ in the end.

17           There have been many books about the  
18 government's coverup of the UFO experience. And the  
19 United States government knows exactly what is going on.

20           And we would agree with that from the  
21 viewpoint of the scriptures; that the people of the  
22 world, the governments of the world, the highest levels  
23 of the powers that be, know exactly what's going on when  
24 it comes to the UFO mystery. They do because their mind  
25 is controlled by Satan, and he is the author of all of

1 this. It's part of the grand dilusion in the end.

2 "And there was war in heaven. Michael and his  
3 angels fought a dragon, and the dragon fought and his  
4 angels, and prevailed not. Neither was their place  
5 found any more in heaven.

6 "And the great dragon was cast out, that old  
7 serpent, called the Devil and Satan which deceiveth the  
8 whole world. He was cast out into the earth, and his  
9 angels were cast out with him.

10 "Now, Satan was cast down to earth, and we  
11 were to observe it from here. It would appear as though  
12 he came down from heaven.

13 "For as in the days that were before the flood  
14 they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in  
15 marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark."

16 Now, Jesus said: "So shall it also be. And  
17 the days of Noah were quite a few. He lived 950 years  
18 before and after the flood. He was there when man began  
19 to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were  
20 born unto them. And the sons of God saw the daughters  
21 of men that they were fair."

22 Now, the book of Enoch gives us some  
23 information about that. "It happened after the sons of  
24 men had multiplied in those days, that the daughters  
25 were born to them, elegant and beautiful."

1                   And when the angels, the sons of heaven came  
2 down, you see, they took wives, each choosing for  
3 himself who they began to approach and with whom they  
4 cohabitated and teaching them sorcery and incantations.

5                   And the whole situation is one where these  
6 were literal fallen angels that came down and mated with  
7 the daughters of men. And they produced a race of  
8 giants, according to the book of Enoch. And many  
9 ancient writings give this interpretation to the sons of  
10 God, mystery of Genesis 6.

11  
12                   "THE SONS OF GOD RETURN."

13  
14                   NARRATOR: Now, what is interesting is that  
15 they said they would return.

16                   "Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in  
17 the latter times some shall depart from the faith,  
18 giving heed to seducing spirits and doctrines of  
19 demons."

20                   Now, the word "seducing" comes from the word  
21 "planos," which if you do a word study, it comes all the  
22 way back to where we get our word "planet."

23  
24                   "SEDUCING = PLANOS (PLANET). IN THE LATTER  
25 TIMES SOME SHALL DEPART FROM THE FAITH, GIVING HEED TO  
IMPOSTERS FROM OTHER PLANETS."

1                   NARRATOR:  Could it be that the interpretation  
2   is in the latter times some shall depart from the faith,  
3   giving heed to imposters from other planets?  That would  
4   be the most literal translation, and that is also  
5   exactly what is happening.

6

7                   "THESE IMPOSTERS ARE DEMONS, PRETENDING TO BE  
8   FROM OUTER SPACE.  IT IS PART OF THE GRAND DILUSION."

8

9                   NARRATOR:  These imposters are actually  
10  demons, pretending to be from outer space.  It is part  
11  of the grand dilusion.

12                   "For this cause, God shall send them strong  
13  dilusion, that they shall believe a lie.

14                   "That they all might be damned if not the  
15  truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

16                   "They reject the concept of creation.

17                   "Even him whose coming is after the working of  
18  Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders."

19                   This would result in UFO contacts of the  
20  first, second and third kind as Satan sends his advanced  
21  guard to prepare man for the grand dilusion.

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"NASA's PROJECT SETI"

(FILM)

MS. TARTER: On the surface of an average planet, circling an ordinary yellow star, an advanced intelligence searches the skies for evidence of life.

Directed by even higher intelligence, machines with brains of silicone patiently sift through faint shards of radio data an unmistakable signal to indicate the first sign of life beyond earth.

Now plans for the most sophisticated SETI search, ever, focus on the Goldstone Deep Space Communication Complex in California's Mojave Desert. It is the site of tests for a possible future NASA project, one not yet funded.

The full-scale NASA system, when operational in the next decade, would be billions of times more powerful than the sum of all previous searches.

For Carl Sagan, a proponent for SETI for many years, his technical progress has made the project unique.

\* \* \* \*

MR. SAGAN: For the first time we're mustering substantial, sophisticated, serious scientific searches for extraterrestrial intelligence. There's never been a time like that before. So there is some chance that in

1 the next few decades we will get the signal from some  
2 spectacularly distant, spectacularly exotic  
3 civilization. And everything on earth will change. It  
4 is possible.

5 \* \* \* \*

7 "THE QUEST FOR CONTACT"

8

(FILM)

9 "NASA'S SEARCH FOR EXTRATERRESTRIAL  
10 INTELLIGENCE. SETI. NARRATED BY JILL TARTER."

11 MS. TARTER: How, why, where and when to  
12 search for life beyond earth has been debated for  
13 centuries. Deciding what sort of signal to look for in  
14 disguise is no easy task.

15 NASA's proposed search focuses on radio, a  
16 portion of the electromagnetic spectrum where nature  
17 produces the least interference for any intelligence  
18 signal.

19 The plan is to use existing radio antennas and  
20 combine them with advanced computer hardware and  
21 software specifically designed for the task.

22 Signal processing equipment suitable for SETI  
23 is constantly becoming more powerful and more efficient,  
24 but also cheaper and smaller than ever before.

25 (NOTE: THERE IS A SMALL SKIP IN THE FILM.)

1 MS. TARTER: -- came up with a way to organize  
2 our developing knowledge and current ignorance.

3 SETI scientists often use what's called The  
4 Drake Equation to illuminate the necessary conditions  
5 for contact, and to provide a rough estimate of the  
6 number of other civilizations.

7 The existence of other technical civilizations  
8 depends upon astronomy, how planets form, comparative  
9 planetology, biochemistry, the role of intelligence in  
10 evolution, technology, and the fate of technical  
11 civilizations.

12 So SETI becomes a way to test our theories of  
13 the origin and evolution of the universe, and the place  
14 of life within it.

15 (END OF FILM.)

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1 (IRON MOUNTAIN REPORT RESUMES)

2 NARRATOR: There are several keys here that we  
3 want to look at as we keep Iron Mountain's report in  
4 mind.

5 "TWO KEYS EVOLUTION IS ACCEPTED. ETs ARE  
6 ACCEPTED. SETI IS IN THE SCHOOL CURRICULUM."

7 NARRATOR: The two primary keys is that  
8 evolution is an accepted fact. And ETs are now accepted  
9 at the highest levels of government.

10 We believe that the SETI program is  
11 camouflaged for what is really going on or the contact  
12 reports that have been gotten out from the government  
13 from the Freedom of Information Act, in fact, cover for  
14 the SETI program.

15 But the two that we believe are going to merge  
16 in the end and introduce mankind to the aliens who are,  
17 in reality, demons and Satan's advanced guard. The  
18 movies that have been produced are very important.

19  
20 "PLANT A SEED. WATER IT. WATCH IT GROW.  
21 REAP THE HARVEST. THE PLAN OF SATAN."

22 NARRATOR: Satan plants a seed, then he waters  
23 it. Then he sits back and watches it grow. And then he  
24 reaps the harvest. And the harvest, of course, is the  
25 loss of millions upon millions of men.

1           "The Day the Earth Stood Still" was produced  
2 many years ago, but is a very important film that it  
3 planted the seed.

4

5           "THE DAY THE EARTH STOOD STILL"  
6           1. WAR MUST STOP.  
7           2. PEACE MUST BE ENFORCED.  
8           3. WORLD GOVERNMENT IS A REQUIREMENT."

7

8           NARRATOR: "The Day the Earth Stood Still"  
9 said that war must stop, peace must be enforced, and  
10 world government is a requirement to get all of this to  
11 happen. The message was very important.

12           "E.T.", a very, very popular movie, taught us  
13 some things as well.

14

15           "E.T."  
16           1. REPTILES ARE CUTE.  
17           2. LOVE IS THE ANSWER.  
18           3. LOVE HEALS.  
19           4. WE ALL EVOLVE IN A DIFFERENT MANNER."

18

19           NARRATOR: "E.T." taught us reptiles are very  
20 cute, that love is the answer, that love heals, but more  
21 importantly that we all evolve in a different manner.

22           You're going to find evolution at the bottom  
23 of all these movies. And "Star Wars" is another one,  
24 how famous they were. Well, they're programming the  
25 human mind for certain things.

- 1 "STAR WARS"  
2 1. EVOLUTION OF RACES.  
3 2. GOOD/EVIL FORCES.  
4 3. UNIVERSAL, ETERNAL FIGHT BETWEEN GOOD AND  
5 EVIL.  
6 4. A FEDERATION OF PLANETS."

7 NARRATOR: One, evolution of the races. Good  
8 and evil forces. A universal, eternal fight between the  
9 forces of good and evil. And more importantly, a  
10 federation of planets.

11 A uniting of the nations, a uniting of all the  
12 planets, mankind will evolve upwards and eventually join  
13 an intergalactic civilization. And this is the  
14 important key note in every one of these movies.

15 "Close Encounters of the Third Kind" was a  
16 very, very important film.

- 17 "CLOSE ENCOUNTERS"  
18 1. EVOLUTION.  
19 2. UNITED NATIONS IS CENTRAL PLAYER.  
20 3. U.S. MILITARY IS CONNECTED TO UN.  
21 4. MANKIND WILL JOIN INTERPLANETARY  
22 CIVILIZATION."

23 NARRATOR: It bases itself on evolution. Two,  
24 that the United Nations is a central player in that  
25 movie. The U.S. military is connected to the United  
26 Nations in that movie. And that mankind will join  
27 interplanetary civilization.

28 It starts by contact, but by exchanges of the

1 races. In other words, some of our people go there, and  
2 some of their people come here.

3

4 "MAJESTIC 12. GOVERNMENT CONTACT WITH  
5 ALIENS."

6

7 NARRATOR: Now, something surfaced not too  
8 long ago called Majestic 12 that dealt with government  
9 contact with aliens. A lot of people laugh at this  
10 document and think it's a hoax. Our research against  
11 the Bible, which say that it is not a hoax, is that this  
12 actually is legitimate and that contact has been made.

13

14 "OPERATION MAJESTIC 12 IS A TOP SECRET  
15 RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT/INTELLIGENCE  
16 OPERATION...ESTABLISHED BY SPECIAL CLASSIFIED EXECUTIVE  
17 ORDER OF PRESIDENT TRUMAN..."

18

19 NARRATOR: Operation Majestic 12 is a top  
20 secret research and development/intelligence operation  
21 established by special classified executive order of  
22 President Truman.

23 Now, this took place back some years ago.  
24 Very interesting, however, what Majestic 12 sets up.

25

26 "A RANCHER REPRESENTED THAT ONE (UFO) HAD  
27 CRASHED IN A REMOTE REGION OF NEW MEXICO..."

28

29

1                   NARRATOR: A rancher reported that one, a UFO,  
2 had crashed in a remote region of New Mexico. You might  
3 have even seen this replayed on Unsolved Mysteries.  
4 They ran a series on this.

5

6                   "A SECRET OPERATION WAS BEGUN TO ASSURE  
7 RECOVERY OF THE WRECKAGE OF THIS OBJECT...AERIAL  
8 RECONNAISSANCE DISCOVERED THAT FOUR SMALL HUMAN-LIKE  
9 BEINGS HAD EJECTED FROM THE CRAFT...ALL FOUR WERE  
10 DEAD...NEWS REPORTERS WERE GIVEN THE EFFECTIVE STORY  
11 THAT THE OBJECT HAD BEEN...A WEATHER BALLOON..."

12                   NARRATOR: A secret operation was begun to  
13 assure recovery of the wreckage of this object, aerial  
14 reconnaissance discovered that four small human-like  
15 beings had ejected from the craft. All four were dead.  
16 News reporters were given the effective story that the  
17 object had been a weather balloon.

18                   They are discounting the UFOs to the public  
19 while they gather the evidence secretly.

20

21                   "THE BIOLOGICAL AND EVOLUTIONARY PROCESSES  
22 RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR DEVELOPMENT HAS APPARENTLY BEEN  
23 QUITE DIFFERENT...FROM THOSE...IN HOMO SAPIENS."

24

25                   NARRATOR: The biological and evolutionary --  
26 there is your key -- processes responsible for their  
27 development has apparently been quite different from  
28 those in homo sapiens.



1 "EVOLUTION IS THEN A PROVEN FACT, INSOFAR AS  
2 THE GOVERNMENT IS CONCERNED. THE ALIENS DID NOT EVOLVE  
3 AS WE DID."

3

4 NARRATOR: Evolution is then a proven fact,  
5 insofar as the government is concerned. They have  
6 accepted evolution as an established fact. The aliens  
7 then did not evolve as we did. This is the very basis  
8 of the grand dilusion.

9

10 "CREATION VERSUS EVOLUTION. EVOLUTION IS  
11 ESSENTIAL FOR THE GRAND DILUSION BECAUSE MAN REJECTED  
12 THE TRUTH OF CREATION BY CHRIST."

12

13 NARRATOR: Creation versus evolution.  
14 Evolution is essential for the grand dilusion because  
15 man rejected the creation of the world and people by  
16 Jesus Christ. So it's very important you understand  
17 that evolution is the key note.

18

19 "...THE ULTIMATE INTENTIONS OF THESE VISITORS  
20 IS COMPLETELY UNKNOWN...(NOT IF YOU READ YOUR BIBLE)."

21 NARRATOR: The ultimate intentions of these  
22 visitors is completely unknown, the report said. But if  
23 you read the Bible, you will know they are demons and  
24 you will know they are the advanced guard of Satan, and  
25 that they are setting up the world for its final ruin

1 and taking of people into eternal hell.

2                   UFOs are real. There's no question about that  
3 they are real. The only question is what are they. And  
4 if you take the evidence of the scriptures, definitely  
5 we believe here at least that they are the sons of God  
6 returning just exactly as they said they would. And all  
7 the occultic literature talks about this.

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1 "AREA 51, GROOM LAKE"

2 NARRATOR: Now, there is an area out west  
3 called Area 51, Groom Lake. There's also Atonapar  
4 (phonetic). There are several areas from which Project  
5 Redlight was developed.

6

7 "PROJECT RED LIGHT. A TOP SECRET TESTING  
8 PROGRAM OF ALIEN TECHNOLOGY FOR DEFENSE."

8

9 NARRATOR: It's a top secret testing program  
10 for alien technology for defense purposes. This is very  
11 interesting that a lot of this stuff is being leaked  
12 right at this moment as we get into this.

13

14 "I HAVE NO COMMENT AS TO WHAT IS GOING ON IN  
15 AREA 51. (CONGRESSMAN HARRY REID AFTER VISITING THE  
16 AREA)."

16

17 NARRATOR: A congressman: I have no comment  
18 as to what is going on in Area 51. That was Congressman  
19 Harry Reid. And he went out there to visit the area  
20 because the air force had made a land grab, and he went  
21 out there on behalf of his constituents to find out why.

22

23 "IT IS SAID THAT PRESIDENT EISENHOWER SIGNED A  
24 TREATY WITH ALIENS IN 1957. PEOPLE FOR TECHNOLOGY."

24

25

1                   NARRATOR: It is said that President  
2 Eisenhower signed a treaty with actual aliens in 1957.  
3 The swap was they could take our people for  
4 experimentation, and we would get technology in  
5 exchange.

6                   In other words, the aliens come to earth. We  
7 take their technology to build our defense mechanisms.  
8 Now, a lot of people think this is ridiculous.

9

10                   "STEALTH."

11

12                   NARRATOR: But if you read what it says about  
13 Babylon, the great, the nation, it gets all of its  
14 technology from Satan.

15

16                   "UFOs ARE ALSO BEING TESTED THERE."

17

18                   NARRATOR: Satan is the one that gives them  
19 the power. And this is why the United Nations is being  
20 brought up, and this is why the United States is so  
21 deeply involved.

22

23                   "IN EXCHANGE FOR TECHNOLOGY, THE U.S.  
24 GOVERNMENT AGREED TO ALLOW THE ALIENS TO EXPERIMENT ON  
HUMANS."

25

1                   NARRATOR: And in exchange for technology, the  
2 U.S. Government agreed to allow the aliens to abduct  
3 humans for experiments.

4

5                   "THIS ACCOUNTS FOR THE LARGE NUMBER OF  
6 ABDUCTIONS REPORTED ALL OVER AMERICA. THIS IS PART OF  
7 THE GRAND DILUSION, WHICH HAS EVOLUTION AT ITS ROOT."

7

8                   NARRATOR: This accounts for the large number  
9 of an abductions reported all over America. This is  
10 part of the grand dilusion which has evolution at the  
11 root of it.

12

13                   "WE HAVE TWO OPTIONS:  
14 1. ALL OF THE 'LEAKS' ARE DISINFORMATION.  
15 2. IT IS REAL, AND THE ALIENS ARE HERE."

15

16                   NARRATOR: Now, you have actually two options.  
17 All of the leaks of this type of information are  
18 disinformation where it is real, and the aliens really  
19 are here.

20

21                   "THE BIBLE EVIDENCE IS THAT IT IS REAL. THE  
22 ALIENS ARE HERE. THEY ARE THE ADVANCED GUARD FOR SATAN.  
23 PART OF THE DILUSION."

23

24                   NARRATOR: The Bible evidence would be that it  
25 is real. The aliens are here, and that they are the

1 advanced guard for Satan. He is programming the human  
2 race for this dilusion, and it's based upon evolution.

3

4 "THE SONS OF GOD OF GENESIS 6 HAVE RETURNED,  
5 AS THEY SAID THEY WOULD IN OCCULT WRITINGS: 'AS IT WAS  
6 IN THE DAYS OF NOAH, SO SHALL IT BE.'"

6

7 NARRATOR: The sons of God of Genesis 6 have  
8 returned, as they said they would in occult writings.

9 And Jesus says: "As it was in the days of  
10 Noah, so shall would it be again. And that's when the  
11 sons of God came down."

12

13 "THE AGENDA OF IRON MOUNTAIN FOR EXTERNAL  
14 THREAT NUMBER 2 HAS BEEN AND IS BEING CARRIED OUT."

14

15

16 NARRATOR: Therefore, the agenda of Iron  
17 Mountain for External Threat Number 2 has been and is  
18 being carried out.

19 Scientists are even going to the UN now to  
20 find out how are we going to answer these aliens from  
21 our SETI contacts at NASA. They believe the UN should  
22 do all of this.

23 And so you see, it elevates the United Nations  
24 to power. And this is very important. It is part of  
25 the Iron Mountain agenda.

1 "IRON MOUNTAIN RECOMMENDATION EXTERNAL THREAT  
2 NUMBER 3."

3 NARRATOR: It might be argued that a  
4 well-armed international police force, operating under  
5 the authority of such a national court, could well serve  
6 (super national) this purpose.

7 In other words, they're going to set up  
8 another threat. This is Threat Number 3 actually.

9  
10 "AN OMNIPRESENT, VIRTUALLY OMNIPOTENT  
11 INTERNATIONAL POLICE FORCE."

12 NARRATOR: An omnipresent, virtually  
13 omnipotent police force. It's an international police  
14 force because, remember, if we go into peace, we have to  
15 dissolve the nations because war is the reason we have  
16 nations.

17 All right. So the report then that was issued  
18 by the state department, freedom from war in the  
19 program, was to establish a permanent international  
20 peace force within the united nations. In other words,  
21 to deliberately bring it up.

22 The peace-keeping capabilities of the United  
23 Nations would be sufficiently strong, and the  
24 obligations of all states under such arrangements  
25 sufficiently far-reaching as to assure peace and the

1 just settlement of differences in a disarmed world.

2           They're going to use the United Nations to  
3 keep the peace. In other words, a world government,  
4 which is exactly what Daniel talked about and Jesus  
5 talked about. And it is very deadly.

6           During Stage 2, states will develop further  
7 the peace-keeping processes of the United Nations to the  
8 end.

9           "THE UNITED NATIONS CAN...DETER ANY THREAT OR  
10 USE OF FORCE..."

11           NARRATOR: The United Nations can effectively  
12 suppress any threat or use of force by anyone, and that  
13 would include America, the American people.

14

15           "OMNIPRESENT OR OMNIPOTENT."

16

17           NARRATOR: It's going to be omnipresent and  
18 it's going to be omnipotent in its ability to handle.  
19 And this is what Revelation says, who can make war with  
20 the beast.

21           Remember that the U.S. and Russia are to have  
22 their internal militaries turned over to the United  
23 Nations in this three-stage process. And we end up with  
24 the UN in total control of the world, a global entity  
25 precisely as Daniel and Revelation talk about. And



1 Jeremiah and Isaiah refer to it, of course, as Babylon.

2           And this process, of course, emerges bringing  
3 out the United Nations as the final in time global  
4 ruling entity, which the Bible refers to as the  
5 apparatus was Antichrist, or we could say the Antichrist  
6 system.

7           And that is why it sits in New York City, the  
8 big city. On the wall of the Security Council is a  
9 phoenix. That picture you're looking at right there is,  
10 in reality, the phoenix bird which is to grow out of the  
11 old world order.

12           America is to be controlled by Russian,  
13 Belgian, Irish and Colombian and Venezuelan troops under  
14 this plan. UN troops are already on U.S. soil. And it  
15 won't be very long before these sites that you're seeing  
16 right here are going to be very commonplace in the  
17 United States. And if the American citizens resist,  
18 they are simply going to be liquidated according to the  
19 Bible.

20           This power will come to pass. They've laid  
21 their plans well. And God has ordained it and is  
22 allowing it to happen. And so it's, in reality, here in  
23 America. It's a judgment against the United States.

24           There are many books written about a United  
25 Nations peace force. So this is not anything we're

1 making up. They come in under the UN charter.

2

3 "BUT THIS PRINCIPLE SHALL NOT PREJUDICE THE  
4 APPLICATION OF ENFORCEMENT MEASURES UNDER CHAPTER VII."

4

5 NARRATOR: The last part of it: This  
6 principle of noninterfering in a nation shall not  
7 prejudice the application of enforcement measures under  
8 Chapter VII.

9 In other words, the United Nations claims that  
10 it doesn't really want to get involved in internal  
11 international affairs, but the opposite is, in reality,  
12 the truth.

13 Chapter VII deals with action with respect to  
14 threats to the peace, breaches of the peace or acts of  
15 aggression. And it's the Security Council itself that  
16 determines the existence of a threat, breach or act of  
17 aggression. And it can even walk in under the threat or  
18 it's a possibility that we might have problems.

19

20 "...SHALL DETERMINE THE EXISTENCE OF ANY  
21 THREAT TO PEACE...BREACH OF PEACE OR ACT OF  
22 AGGRESSION..."

22

23 NARRATOR: And they determine the existence of  
24 any threat to the peace. So they can come in if they  
25 choose to on very fragile grounds, which is exactly what

1 they did in Somalia.

2           Should the Security Council consider that  
3 measures provided in 41, which are more economic -- I  
4 don't know exactly what word to use, but "sanctions" I  
5 guess is the best word to cover it. If that doesn't  
6 work, if economic sanctions do not work, then they can  
7 resort to military powers.

8

9           "...MAY TAKE SUCH ACTION BY AIR, SEA OR LAND  
10 FORCES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO MAINTAIN OR RESTORE  
INTERNATIONAL PEACE AND SECURITY."

11

12           NARRATOR: And they can use whatever they have  
13 to to maintain or restore international peace.

14           Now, Psalm 2 says that:

15           "The kings of the earth set themselves, and  
16 the rulers take counsel together, against the Lord, and  
17 against his anointed."

18           Where do the rulers of the world meet? They  
19 meet at the United Nations. And this is where they take  
20 their counsel together. And the United Nations is,  
21 according to the Bible, Antichrist, Anti-God, to its  
22 very core. It is, in fact, the substitute for God and  
23 Christ on planet earth. They intend to take it for  
24 themselves.

25           "The fourth beast shall be the fourth kingdom

1 upon earth which shall be diverse from all kingdoms, and  
2 shall devour the whole earth, and shall tread it down,  
3 and shall break it in pieces.

4 "And the 10 horns out of this kingdom are 10  
5 kings."

6

7 "DIVERSE. NOT A KINGDOM OR NATION. UN IS A  
8 TREATY POWER. IT IS DIFFERENT THAN ANY ENTITY EVER  
9 CREATED."

9

10 NARRATOR: Now, it's a diverse kingdom. The  
11 United Nations is not a kingdom, and it's not a nation.  
12 It exists solely by treaty power by an arrangement of  
13 nations itself.

14

15 "THE UNITED NATIONS IS TO BE BROUGHT UP TO  
16 FULL GLOBAL POWER WITH AN ARMY SO POWERFUL NONE CAN  
17 FIGHT AGAINST IT."

17

18 NARRATOR: The United Nations is to be brought  
19 up to full global power with an army so powerful that  
20 none can fight against it. That's the entire plan, and  
21 that is exactly what the Bible talks about for the end  
22 times.

23

24 "THE UNITED NATIONS WILL BREAK INTO PIECES THE  
25 WHOLE WORLD. ARTICLE 52, REGIONALISM."

25

1           NARRATOR: It will also break into pieces the  
2 entire world, and that's done under Article 52 which  
3 deals with regionalism which is, in fact, breaking the  
4 world into pieces.

5           And this is how they do it. They actually  
6 subdivide the world into 10 regions. That came out of  
7 the Club of Rome. And here are the regions on the TV  
8 screen.

9           Region 1, of course, is North America. And  
10 it's Region 1 by virtue of the fact it -- North America  
11 and particularly the United States -- is the primary  
12 power behind the United Nations enabling this to happen.

13           The United States itself is broken down into  
14 10 federal regions. We have global regions and now we  
15 have national regions.

16

17           "WORLD REGIONS.  
18           NATIONAL REGIONS.  
19           ELECTED OFFICIALS TO APPOINTED OFFICIALS  
20           CENTRALIZED POWER."

19

20           NARRATOR: In our country, they are simply  
21 called federal regions. And we're moving, in effect,  
22 from elected officials to appointed officials to  
23 nonelected bureaucrats who are appointed.

24           Now, each region has different states in it,  
25 and the number of states varies with each particular

1 region. Then each state is subdivided up into its  
2 particular regions. Many times it falls along county  
3 lines. Many times it doesn't.

4 Overlapping all of it, of course, is of course  
5 the grids that keep getting smaller and smaller, which  
6 is the reason why thousands, actually millions, of  
7 Americans are getting address changes.

8 They're going under the United Nations grid  
9 system which divides the world into tiny pieces, which  
10 is exactly what Daniel said. They can get it right down  
11 to your house number. In fact, they can get it down to  
12 about 10 square yards of turf.

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(FILM)

NARRATOR #2: Recently NASA's Landsat 4 satellite shown here just before its trip into space was launched at the western test range by a delta rocket.

This Landsat is the fourth in a series of NASA spacecraft designed to continuously collect accurate information on earth's resources. More than 100 nations will make use of the information gathered by Landsat 4.

In land use planning, mineral exploration and agriculture, Landsat project scientist Dr. Vincent Solomonson has described a new instrument on the satellite's thematic mapper.

\* \* \* \*

DR. SOLOMONSON: In urban planning, the thematic mapper will be very effective. Features that were blurred or hazy over cities, as viewed by the multispectrum scanner on the Landsats 1 through 3, will be seen more clearly from the thematic mapper. And as a result, urban planning will be able to manage and monitor the span of the urban sprawl into the surrounding countryside.

\* \* \* \*

NARRATOR #2: The major receiving and processing facility for Landsat data is located at

1 NASA's Goddard Space Flight Center in Greenbelt,  
2 Maryland. Completing its three-year mission, Landsat 4  
3 is designed to be retrieved by the space shuttle.

4 (END OF FILM.)

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1 (IRON MOUNTAIN REPORT RESUMES)

2 NARRATOR: So what we have are 10 federal  
3 regions. We have 10 federal regional councils, which  
4 are miniature Washingtons in each federal capitol.

5 We are being regionalized. And pretty soon,  
6 there won't be any such thing as this counties or  
7 states.

8

9 "FROM STATE CONTROL TO TOTAL FEDERAL CONTROL."

10

11 NARRATOR: So what we're doing is going from  
12 county and state control to total federal control. And  
13 then the federal government is losing its control to the  
14 United Nations. This is globalism.

15

16 "THIS LEADS TO THE FEDERALIZATION OF OUR  
17 POLICE OR 'SECURITY' FORCE."

17

18 NARRATOR: This leads to the federalization of  
19 our police or the security forces within the U.S. And  
20 this is really in total violation of the constitutional  
21 implications, but they're not paying any attention to  
22 the constitution.

23 The internal security forces are not your  
24 peace-keeping -- UN peace-keeping troops -- the  
25 peace-keeping troops are there to put down actual

1 revolutions and wars.

2

3 "THE MJTF POLICE. A NATIONAL POLICE FORCE."

4

5 NARRATOR: The internal security forces are  
6 there more for crime control and rounding up people.  
7 Predominantly, the MJTF police will be the national  
8 police force. And this is George Bush and Clinton and  
9 the rest of them have continuously pushed this arms  
10 control treaty because they have to disarm us in order  
11 to make this thing work. If you will recall, we  
12 discussed that in the constitutional crisis.

13

14 "THE MJTF POLICE, MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL TASK  
15 FORCE POLICE, REMOVES ALL CITIZENS FROM LOCAL, COUNTY  
16 AND STATE PROTECTIONS."

16

17 NARRATOR: The MJTF police means  
18 multi-jurisdictional task force police. And it removes  
19 all citizens from local, county and state protections  
20 that you had under the law. And they're just abolishing  
21 all of this. And the MJTF mission, we believe, is a  
22 house-to-house search and seizure of people.

23

24 "ALL FEDERAL AGENCY UNITS, NATIONAL GUARD  
25 UNITS, STATE & LOCAL POLICE CONVERTS STREET GANGS AS  
NEEDED INTO DEPUTIZED POLICE UNITS."

1                   NARRATOR: It is made up of national guard  
2 units, state and local police. Converts street gangs as  
3 needed into deputized police. House-to-house search and  
4 seizure, separation and categorization of men, women and  
5 children as prisoners in large areas.

6                   Now, you have to understand that in order to  
7 liquidate the millions of people that Jesus Christ says  
8 is going to be liquidated, they have to plan this out  
9 long before it happens.

10

11                   "1965, OFFICE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE,  
12 OLEA, UNDER DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE."

13

14                   NARRATOR: 1965, they started the Office of  
15 Law Enforcement Assistance.

16

17                   "1968, OMNIBUS CRIME CONTROL ACT CONVERTS OLEA  
18 TO LEAA, 'LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE ADMINISTRATION'."

19

20                   NARRATOR: Then came in 1968 the Omnibus Crime  
21 Control Act which converted the OLEA to the Law  
22 Enforcement Assistance Administration.

23

24                   "1971, LEAA CALLS FOR A REGIONALIZED POLICE  
25 FORCE."

26

27                   NARRATOR: They called in 1971 for a  
28 regionalized police force.

1                   "1971, ADVISORY COMMISSION ON  
2 INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS ISSUES A PAMPHLET TITLED  
3 M-67."

3

4                   NARRATOR: In 1971, an advisory commission on  
5 intergovernmental relations issued a pamphlet called  
6 M-67 which called for a special multicounty and  
7 interstate police force.

8

9                   "1971, M-67 CALLS FOR...'SPECIAL POLICE TASK  
10 FORCES...A SPECIAL MULTICOUNTY OR INTERSTATE POLICE  
11 FORCE'..."

11

12                  NARRATOR: In other words, the merging of all  
13 police forces into one federal group.

14

15                  "1973, LEAA AGAIN CALLS FOR THE ELIMINATION BY  
16 MERGER OF SMALL POLICE FORCES."

16

17                  NARRATOR: The LEAA in 1973 made calls for the  
18 elimination by merger of small police forces. This is  
19 exactly what Germany did under Hitler.

20

21                  "ALL DICTATORSHIPS...HAVE TWO COMMON  
22 CHARACTERISTICS: GENERAL CONFISCATION OF GUNS IN ORDER  
23 TO PREVENT INTERNAL REBELLION..."

23

24                  NARRATOR: All dictatorships have two common  
25 characteristics. General confiscation of guns in order

1 to prevent internal rebellion --

2

3 "...AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NATIONAL POLICE  
4 FORCE TO ENFORCE THE EDICTS OF THE DICTATOR, COLONEL  
5 ROBERTS."

5

6 NARRATOR: -- and the establishment of a  
7 national police force to enforce the edicts of the  
8 dictator. We are following Nazi Germany almost to the  
9 exact letter.

10

11 "1979, PRESIDENT CARTER ISSUES EXECUTIVE ORDER  
12 12148 ESTABLISHING THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT  
13 AGENCY, FEMA."

13

14 NARRATOR: Carter issued an executive order  
15 12148, and he established the Federal Emergency  
16 Management Agency known as FEMA.

17

18 "FEMA ABSORBS THE LEAA AND BECOMES THE PRIMARY  
19 CONTROL ORGANIZATION FOR THE INTERNAL SECURITY OF THE  
20 UNITED STATES IN AN 'EMERGENCY'."

20

21 NARRATOR: FEMA absorbed the LEAA and became  
22 the primary control organization for internal security  
23 of the United States in an emergency.

24

25 They're gearing this thing towards an  
emergency. That emergency is going to be World War III,

1 and it ushers in this whole system.

2 FEMA has many interesting programs. Rex 82  
3 Bravo, Rex 84 Alpha, Helex 2, Rex Alpha, Night Train 84,  
4 Cable Splicer/Garden Plot. These are all martial law  
5 training exercises. The plan is to bring America under  
6 martial law. We believe they know the American people  
7 would never accept the system except if an external  
8 emergency were given.

9

10 "THESE EXERCISES CONCERN THEMSELVES WITH  
11 MARTIAL LAW. THE UN SYSTEM IS A MARTIAL LAW SYSTEM FOR  
12 LAW ENFORCEMENT."

12

13 NARRATOR: The UN system, remember, is a  
14 martial law military system. Under the executive orders  
15 of FEMA, mandatory registration of all people, including  
16 babies and children, in the United States.

17 At the United States Post Office, they have  
18 boxes of them. We already know about it. They're  
19 marked For Emergency Use Only.

20 The primary one here to look at is 11000 -  
21 seizure of all civilians in work brigades which is, in  
22 reality, slavery. It includes the rights to split up  
23 families as well.

24 In essence, what will happen in America is  
25 going to be worse than the Communist Revolution in

1 Russia. This plan provides the basis for the deployment  
2 and employment of military resources including national  
3 guard personnel for civilian disturbances.

4

5 "IRON MOUNTAIN EXTERNAL THREAT NUMBER 3 HAS  
6 BEEN AND IS NOW BEING IMPLEMENTED."

6

7 NARRATOR: So Iron Mountain External Threat  
8 Number 3 has been and is now being implemented; an  
9 omnipotent police force.

10

11 "IRON MOUNTAIN ECONOMIC SUBSTITUTES FOR WAR,  
12 THE SPACE PROGRAM."

12

13 NARRATOR: Next on the list is the space  
14 program as an economic substitute for war. It is the  
15 development of a long-range sequence of space-research  
16 projects with largely unattainable goals.

17 This kind of program offers several advantages  
18 lacking in the social welfare model. It's the nearest  
19 modern equivalent yet devised to pyramid-building and  
20 similar ritualistic enterprises of ancient societies.

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(FILM)

PRESIDENT KENNEDY: "We choose to go to the moon in this decay and do the other things, not because they are easy, but because they are hard, because that goal will serve to organize and measure the best of our energies and skills because that challenge is one that we're willing to accept. One we are unwilling to postpone. And one we intend to win and the others, too."

\* \* \* \*

NARRATOR #2: Everything associated with the Saturn V was huge. The rocket itself, the building where it was assembled and the crawler transporter that carried it to the launch pad.

The fully-loaded Apollo Saturn V was 363 feet tall. Its main engines alone generated 160 million horsepower, and its full pumps pushed fuel to the engines with the force of 30 diesel locomotives. As Saturn V lifted off Launch Complex 39 for the first time, it weighed more than 2800 tons.

\* \* \* \*

(FILM)

NARRATOR #2: Across the country and around the world, the Apollo 11 crew were welcomed back as heroes. Before project Apollo ended, six additional



1 flights to the moon were made, and all but one were  
2 highly successful. Then ASUTP, Apollo's Soil Use Test  
3 Project, a joint endeavor between the Soviet Union and  
4 the United States, the mission called for a mutual  
5 docking and crew exchange to develop the necessary  
6 equipment for international space rescues.

7           We've looked back at planet earth with Landsat  
8 remote since. Satellites, crops, forests, pollution all  
9 can be photographed in great detail to help us better  
10 manage our earth's resources.

11           As of now, two-thirds of the planets in our  
12 solar system have been explored. And by the end of this  
13 decade, we will have explored most of the rest,  
14 including Uranus and Neptune.

15           Space Shuttle 5, the first operational flight,  
16 two commercial communication satellites were hauled into  
17 orbit; one for satellite business systems, and one for  
18 TELUS out of Canada. Their deployment was a complete  
19 success.

20           Space Shuttle 6 was the second operational  
21 mission, and flight one for Challenger, this country's  
22 newest spacecraft. After launching a 5,000-pound  
23 tracking and data relay satellite from the payload bay,  
24 mission specialist astronauts Story Musgrave and Donald  
25 Peterson were the first Americans in nine years to walk

1 in space, practice needed for satellite repair work.

2           Historically, the space program has proceeded  
3 in a building-block fashion. And toward that end, NASA  
4 has begun looking at the next logical step, a possible  
5 future space station, a permanent presence in space.

6           The station will serve as a scientific and  
7 technological laboratory, as well as an operations base  
8 from which satellites could be serviced and large  
9 structures assembled.

10           One of the highest priorities is to develop a  
11 clear understanding of a station's proper role in the  
12 total space program so that if and when it is proposed  
13 for development, the station will be a truly significant  
14 national asset, one that would ensure continued American  
15 prominence in space.

16   \* \* \* \*

17           PRESIDENT REAGAN: "The space program in  
18 general, or the shuttle program in particular, have gone  
19 a long way to help our country capture its spirit of  
20 vitality and confidence. The pioneer spirit still  
21 flourishes in America. In the future as in the past,  
22 our freedom, independence and national well-being will  
23 be tied to new achievements, new discoveries and pushing  
24 back new frontiers. We must look aggressively to the  
25 future by demonstrating the potential of the shuttle and

1 establishing a more permanent presence in space."

2 \* \* \* \*

3 "IRON MOUNTAIN ECONOMIC SUBSTITUTE FOR WAR  
4 NUMBER 1 HAS BEEN IMPLEMENTED."

5 "IRON MOUNTAIN ECONOMIC SUBSTITUTE FOR WAR  
6 NUMBER 2, LONG-TERM DISARMAMENT PROCEDURES."

7 NARRATOR #2: Even when ratified, the INF  
8 Treaty will not totally eliminate the nuclear threat to  
9 Eurasia. The vast nuclear arsenal possessed by the USSR  
10 and the variety of delivery systems available still  
11 present a significant threat.

12 (END OF FILM.)

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1 (IRON MOUNTAIN REPORT RESUMES)

2 NARRATOR: The organization of fail-safe  
3 inspection machinery could well be ritualized in a  
4 manner similar to that of established military  
5 processes. Inspection teams might be very like armies,  
6 and their technical equipment might be very like weapons  
7 inflating the inspection budget.

8 In other words, what they want to do is they  
9 want to expand this.

10

11 "INSPECTION MACHINERY COULD WELL BE  
12 RITUALIZED...INSPECTION TEAMS MIGHT BE LIKE VERY  
13 ARMIES..."

13

14 NARRATOR: So what do we have, the INF Treaty  
15 where it says could well be ritualized. According to  
16 Iron Mountain, inspection teams might be like very  
17 armies.

18 And that's exactly what has happened. We have  
19 a great ritual of disarmament. It's very interesting  
20 what you find when you start digging into the INF Treaty  
21 hearings.

22

23 "LIMITED TEST BAN - 1963.  
24 NON-PROLIFERATION - 1968.  
25 ABM TREATY - 1972.  
ASSAULT ONE, ASSAULT TWO.  
INF TREATY. A LONG PROCESS."

1                   NARRATOR: Limited Test Ban -- let's take a  
2 look at all the treaties. Limited Test Ban, 1963.  
3 Non-Proliferation, 1968. The ABM Treaty, 1972. The  
4 Assault One, the Assault Two, the INF Treaty. Very  
5 long, drawn-out process. And this is exactly what Iron  
6 Mountain recommended be done.

7                   One of the most important elements of the INF  
8 Treaty is the President establishes in this area  
9 including on-site inspection, one layer of the regime  
10 builds upon another.

11                   And the whole thing becomes elongated, and it  
12 actually becomes a monster in and of itself. The data  
13 exchanges required are really immense, and so it  
14 requires an elaborate governmental system in order to  
15 accommodate all of this.

16

17                   "IRON MOUNTAIN RECOMMENDATION NUMBER 2 HAS  
18 BEEN IMPLEMENTED."

19

19                   NARRATOR: And so Iron Mountain Recommendation  
20 Number 2 has definitely been implemented.

21                   The second one is the universal health care  
22 was a recommendation of Iron Mountain.

23

24                   "IRON MOUNTAIN RECOMMENDATION NUMBER 3,  
25 UNIVERSAL HEALTH CARE FOR ALL."

25

1                   NARRATOR: Universal health care for all.  
2 It's an economic substitute for the war economy. It's  
3 very interesting how all of this works.

4                   Health: Drastic expansion of medical  
5 research, education and training facilities; hospital  
6 and clinic construction; the general objective of  
7 complete government guaranteed health care for all.  
8 That's exactly what Clinton has introduced to the  
9 American people.

10

11                   "PRESIDENT CLINTON ANNOUNCES HEALTH CARE  
12 REFORM: UNIVERSAL MANDATORY HEALTH INSURANCE."

13                   NARRATOR: He announces a universal health  
14 care and mandatory insurance presently. So they're  
15 putting everything in place exactly as Iron Mountain  
16 told them to do.

17                   It's universal and you cannot exempt yourself  
18 from it. And it is causing a lot of trouble around the  
19 nation, but the arguments are not going to be on that  
20 basis.

21                   What is going to happen is we're going to be  
22 issued eventually a global identification card, and that  
23 is the purpose of this whole thing. The medical card  
24 has only one purpose. That's to get the foot in the  
25 door for the mark system.

1 "IRON MOUNTAIN'S THIRD RECOMMENDATION IS BEING  
2 IMPLEMENTED."

3 NARRATOR: Iron Mountain's third  
4 recommendation is being implemented.

5  
6 "IRON MOUNTAIN ECONOMIC SUBSTITUTE NUMBER 4, A  
7 NEW EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM."

8 NARRATOR: Iron Mountain Economic Substitute  
9 Number 4 on new educational system to bring in  
10 globalism.

11 Under the United Nations, UNESCO,  
12 Congressional Record, the greater conspiracy to destroy  
13 the United States. Education for freedom and world  
14 understanding.

15 You see, all of this is designed to bring us  
16 into a world system, a global system under the control  
17 of the United Nations.

18 The second manifesto was U.S. Office of  
19 Education, the implementation of the program of  
20 surrender through education.

21 In other words, they destroy Americans,  
22 national pride and put us under the United Nations. And  
23 the NEA is leading in this. They even say it  
24 themselves, teaching about globalism and the world  
25 system.

1 "ENDURING PEACE CANNOT BE ATTAINED UNTIL THE  
2 NATION STATES SURRENDER TO A WORLD ORGANIZATION..."

3

4 NARRATOR: They say enduring peace cannot be  
5 attained until the nation states surrender to a world  
6 organization.

7 This is found out during the Reece committee  
8 hearings in Congress:

9 Putting the evidence together, we conclude the  
10 NEA has been an important element in the tax-exempt  
11 world to indoctrinate American youth with  
12 internationalism --

13

14 "...TO INDOCTRINATE AMERICAN YOUTH WITH  
15 INTERNATIONALISM."

16 "THE IRON MOUNTAIN AGENDA IS TO BRING IN A ONE  
17 WORLD SYSTEM."

18 NARRATOR: -- which is synonymous with a lot  
19 of communist, illuminist, whatever you want to call it.

20 The Iron Mountain agenda is being carried out.  
21 Outcome-based education, the developing of leaders for  
22 restructuring the schools, change agents. Parents are  
23 beginning to get upset that they are not putting it  
24 together. American 2000, a national strategy to change  
25 every nation, every family. Everything is going down



1 exactly as Iron Mountain said it should.

2           Global education is nothing more than a  
3 promotion of the United Nations and to destroy the  
4 Constitution of the United States to bring us out from  
5 the constitution and merge us into the UN.

6           That's what they're going to do. To improve  
7 learning and teaching by providing a national framework  
8 for educational reform, to promote research, consensus  
9 building and systematic changes needed to ensure.

10           You see, everything has to be changed. Guess  
11 where the changes all lead to? And guess who is behind  
12 it? If you look, Robert Muller, former UN Second  
13 General to the UN, member of the planetary citizens,  
14 wrote the global core curriculum; Marilyn Ferguson, The  
15 Aquarian Conspiracy, The New Age. This is all being  
16 integrated into the educational system of America. And  
17 it's called America 2000, and it is extremely  
18 subversive.

19           The national and international powerplay for  
20 education, it's going to go through because God has  
21 decreed it will go through. And UNESCO is behind it.

22           Gorbachev: We parted with the old world,  
23 rejecting it once and for all. We are moving toward a  
24 new world, the world of communism. We shall never  
25 depart from it.

1                   Books are on the market explaining all of  
2 this. And we don't have time in this video to get into  
3 it.

4                   "IRON MOUNTAIN RECOMMENDATION 4 IS BEING  
5 IMPLEMENTED."

6                   NARRATOR: Iron Mountain Recommendation Number  
7 4 is being implemented.

8

9                   "IRON MOUNTAIN SOCIOLOGICAL SUBSTITUTES FOR  
10 WAR, SLAVERY."

11                   NARRATOR: Iron Mountain sociological  
12 substitute for war, slavery. Another possible surrogate  
13 for the control of potential enemies of society is the  
14 reintroduction in some form consistent with modern  
15 technology and political processes of slavery.

16

17                   "FOR THE CONTROL OF POTENTIAL ENEMIES OF  
18 SOCIETY IS THE REINTRODUCTION...OF SLAVERY."

19                   NARRATOR: For the control of potential  
20 enemies of a society.

21

22                   "ANYONE THAT DOES NOT AGREE WITH THE NEW ORDER  
23 IS AN 'ENEMY OF SOCIETY' AND IS THEREFORE SUBJECT TO  
24 HARD LABOR."

24

25

1                   NARRATOR:  Anyone that does not agree with the  
2  New World Order is an enemy of society, and is therefore  
3  subject to slavery.

4

5                   "DETENTION CENTERS, CONCENTRATION CAMPS, WORK  
6  CAMPS ARE ASSOCIATED WITH FORCED LABOR."

6

7                   NARRATOR:  Detention centers and concentration  
8  camps, work camps are associated with forced labor which  
9  is, in reality, slavery.

10                  Seizure under the executive orders of all  
11  civilians and work brigades, that's forced labor, that's  
12  slavery, which includes the rights to split up families.

13

14                  "FEMA/MILITARY DETENTION CENTERS SET UP UNDER  
15  REX-84.  THERE ARE OVER 130 SUCH FACILITIES IN AMERICA."

15

16                  NARRATOR:  There are concentration camps,  
17  detention centers all over the United States set up  
18  under FEMA under Rex 84.  And at last count, we had 130  
19  such facilities in the United States of America.

20                  In Arizona you'll see, for example, some  
21  there.  We've got one here in Wisconsin.  Concentration  
22  camps for U.S. citizens.

23                  "MISSION STATEMENT MJTF POLICE.  TO CONDUCT  
24  HOUSE-TO-HOUSE AND SEIZURE AND SEPARATION AND  
25  CATEGORIZATION OF MEN, WOMEN AND CHILDREN IN LARGE  
NUMBERS..."

25

1                   NARRATOR: The MJTF police to conduct  
2 house-to-house search and seizure and separation and  
3 categorization of men, women and children and babies.

4

5                   "...CATEGORIZATION AND TRANSFER TO DETENTION  
6 FACILITIES AND THE RUNNING OF DETENTION FACILITIES..."

6

7                   NARRATOR: Categorization and transfer to  
8 detention facilities and the running of detention  
9 facilities.

10

11                   "...IRON MOUNTAIN SLAVERY RECOMMENDATION PART  
12 2, MANDATORY SERVICE."

12

13                   NARRATOR: Iron Mountain Slavery  
14 Recommendation Number 2 is mandatory service.

15

16                   "A FORM OF 'UNIVERSAL' SERVICE...TURN TO SOME  
17 VARIANT FORM OF THE PEACE CORPS OR...JOB CORPS..."

17

18                   NARRATOR: A form of universal service turn to  
19 some variant form of the peace corps or the job corps.

20

21                   "IT IS ENTIRELY POSSIBLE THAT THE DEVELOPMENT  
22 OF A SOPHISTICATED FORM OF SLAVERY MAY BE AN ABSOLUTE  
23 PREREQUISITE FOR SOCIAL CONTROL IN A WORLD AT PEACE."

23

24                   NARRATOR: It is entirely possible that the  
25 development of a sophisticated form of slavery may be an

1 absolute prerequisite for social control in a world of  
2 peace.

3           Now, this is just incredible when you really  
4 stop and look at what they're actually saying. In  
5 relationship to Biblical prophecies, remember Jesus said  
6 they're going to round you up and kill you.

7

8           "PRESIDENT CLINTON HAS AUTHORIZED 'BOOT CAMPS'  
9 FOR YOUNG OFFENDERS. IS THIS THE BEGINNING OF A LARGER  
PROGRAM FOR SOCIAL 'REORIENTATION'?"

10

11           NARRATOR: President Clinton has authorized  
12 boot camps for young offenders. Is this the beginning  
13 of a larger scale (sic) for social reorientation? Like  
14 the communists do?

15           America 2000, the national plan that's going  
16 into our schools, requires mandatory community service.  
17 There are calls going out all the time.

18

19           "PRESIDENT BUSH AND CLINTON HAVE CALLED FOR  
20 MANDATORY COMMUNITY SERVICE FOR ALL YOUTH."

21

22           NARRATOR: President Bush and Clinton have  
23 called for mandatory community service for all youth up  
24 to, say, two years, mandatory service. You can serve  
25 military service or some other place, but you are going  
to serve.

1                   "IRON MOUNTAIN SOCIOLOGICAL SUBSTITUTE FOR WAR  
NUMBER 1 IS BEING IMPLEMENTED."

2

3                   NARRATOR: The substitute for war is being  
4 implemented.

5

6                   "IRON MOUNTAIN SOCIOLOGICAL SUBSTITUTE FOR WAR  
NUMBER 2 'BLOOD GAMES'."

7

8                   NARRATOR: Iron Mountain sociological  
9 substitute for war number 2 is called blood games.

10                   Game theorists have suggested, in other  
11 contexts, the development of blood games for the  
12 effective control of individual aggressive impulses.

13                   More realistically, such a ritual might be  
14 socialized, in the manner of the Spanish Inquisition and  
15 the less formal witch trials of other periods, for  
16 purposes of social purification, state security, or  
17 other rationale both acceptable and credible to postwar  
18 societies.

19

20                   "...INQUISITION...WITCH TRIALS...FOR THE  
PURPOSE OF 'SOCIAL PURIFICATION (STATE SECURITY)' OR  
21 OTHER RATIONALE..."

22

23                   NARRATOR: Inquisitions, witch trials, for the  
24 purpose of social purification, state security, which is  
25 the key one.

1 "SUCH A RITUAL MIGHT BE SOCIALIZED..."

2

3 NARRATOR: Such a ritual might be socialized.  
4 In other words, they make it into a big social event  
5 like the inquisitions were.

6 We saw part of that beginning to unravel when  
7 we watched the Branch Davidian invasion and subsequent  
8 massacre of David Koresh and his group. A lot went down  
9 at Waco that very few Christians understand.

10

11 "DAVID KORESH AND THE BRANCH DAVIDIANS WERE  
12 'DEMONIZED' BY THE NATIONAL MEDIA. THEY WERE TRIED,  
13 JUDGED AND EXECUTED IN A SOCIAL RITUAL."

13

14 NARRATOR: David Koresh, the Branch Davidians,  
15 were demonized by the national media, first of all.  
16 They were tried, judged and executed in a social ritual  
17 in total violation of every right guaranteed under state  
18 and federal constitutions.

19

20 "THE WACO MASSACRE FOLLOWED ALL POINTS OF  
21 RITUALIZED KILLING. THEY WERE A CULT, AND IT WAS FOR  
22 'SOCIAL PURIFICATION'. THEY DESERVED IT."

22

23 NARRATOR: The Waco massacre followed all  
24 points of ritualized killing. They were a cult. It was  
25 for social purification and, therefore, they deserved

1 what they got.

2

3 "THEIR COMPOUND WAS RAIDED BY A FEDERAL  
4 ASSAULT GROUP WHEN, IN FACT, THERE WAS NO EVIDENCE OF  
5 ANY CRIME."

6

7 NARRATOR: Their compound was raided by  
8 federal assault groups when, in fact, there was no  
9 evidence of any crime having been committed.

10

11 "EVEN IF THERE WAS EVIDENCE FOR A CRIME, IT IS  
12 THE DUTY OF THE LOCAL SHERIFF TO SERVE WARRANTS, NOT THE  
13 FEDERAL GOVERNMENT."

14 "THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES CAME  
15 UNDER SEVERE ATTACK AT WACO, AND THE AMERICAN PEOPLE  
16 CHEERED."

17

18 NARRATOR: They will be next. The vast  
19 majority of American people have allowed the media to  
20 brainwash them, and they accept as truth whatever the  
21 media has told them.

22 In order to socialize the ritual of killing  
23 the innocent, the rationale that is acceptable to  
24 society must be found. This requires the deliberate  
25 distortion and manipulation of the actual facts to make  
the murders justified.

This ritualization by the media is now  
becoming a standard, and whatever the government says



1 about someone is handed out as truth. Very few  
2 Americans understand what happened at Waco. It appears  
3 from the evidence that Koresh was an 'experiment' in  
4 ritualized killing, and it was fully rationalized.

5 The demonization of Koresh and his group began  
6 well prior to the raid itself. It was intensified as  
7 the standoff continued. Koresh was 'evil,' his  
8 followers were evil, and therefore they had to be  
9 liquidated.

10 President Clinton said Koresh was the killer,  
11 and this is exactly how the rationalization works. You  
12 always blame the target group or person and make them  
13 the 'enemy' of the state. Thus, they become a problem  
14 to 'state security' and to society as a whole, and the  
15 need for 'social purification' is accepted by the  
16 general population.

17 (FILM)

18 PRESIDENT CLINTON: Yesterday's action ended  
19 in a horrible human tragedy. Mr. Koresh's response to  
20 demands to surrender by federal agents was to destroy  
21 himself and murder the children who were his captives,  
22 as well as all the other people who were there who did  
23 not survive. He killed those he controlled, and he  
24 bears ultimate responsibility for the carnage that  
25 ensued.

1 "THE RANDY WEAVER CASE. RUBY RIDGE, IDAHO"

2 (FILM)

3 MR. WEAVER: In the papers before I was going  
4 to go to court, they called me "The White Supremacist"  
5 and all that.

6 \* \* \* \*

7 (FILM)

8 MR. SPENCE: ...vehicles of demonization that  
9 we are all victims of. The federal government decides  
10 it is going to prosecute somebody. They sort of  
11 demonize them.

12 \* \* \* \*

13 INTERMISSION

14 "IRON MOUNTAIN BLOOD GAMES."

15 "THE CONSTITUTIONAL CRISIS IN AMERICA TOWARDS  
16 MARTIAL LAW."

17 \* \* \* \*

18 MR. SPENCE: Do you want to give your federal  
19 agents that leeway to just say when they kill American  
20 citizens, that things -- it just went wrong? We just  
21 have a mother here dead. We have a little boy dead.  
22 And just things went wrong.

23 (END OF FILM.)

24

25

1 "FEMA REVISITED."

2 "THEY HAD BEEN ORDERED TO KILL THE WEAVERS  
3 REGARDLESS OF ANY THREAT FAMILY MEMBERS POSED TO  
4 GOVERNMENT PERSONNEL."

4

5 NARRATOR: During the Weaver trial, it was  
6 admitted by federal agents that they had been ordered to  
7 kill the Weavers regardless of any threat family members  
8 posed to government personnel. Now, I want you to think  
9 about how serious that is.

10

11 "WHAT WAS THE CHARGE AGAINST VICKY WEAVER?  
12 WHAT CRIME AGAINST THE STATE HAD SHE COMMITTED THAT  
13 WARRANTED HER EXECUTION?"

13

14 NARRATOR: What was the charge against Vicky  
15 Weaver? What crime against the state had she committed  
16 that warranted her execution by the federal government?

17

18 "INDEED, SHE WAS NOT CHARGED WITH ANY CRIME  
19 WHATSOEVER, YET THE U.S. GOVERNMENT ORDERED HER SHOT ON  
20 SIGHT!"

20

21 NARRATOR: Indeed, she was not charged with  
22 any crime whatsoever, yet the U.S. Government ordered  
23 her shot on sight. A virtual killing. It was murder.

24

25

1                   "THIS IS MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE. IT IS  
2 COLD-BLOODED RITUALISTIC 'SOCIAL PURIFICATION' BECAUSE  
3 THE WEAVERS HELD A VIEWPOINT NOT 'POLITICALLY CORRECT'."

3

4                   NARRATOR: It was murder in the first degree.  
5 It is cold-blooded ritualistic social purification  
6 because the Weavers held a viewpoint not politically  
7 correct.

8

9                   "THE WEAVER CASE, ALONG WITH THE BRANCH  
10 DAVIDIANS, PROVES WE ARE IN THE MIDDLE OF THE FINAL  
11 BATTLE FOR THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES."

11

12                  NARRATOR: The Weaver case, along with the  
13 Branch Davidians, proves we are in the middle of the  
14 final battle for the Constitution of the United States.

15                  There are many, many enemies in America that  
16 want to get rid of our constitution and destroy our  
17 rights.

18

19                  "THE WAR HAS NOW SHIFTED FROM A PAPER AND  
20 LEGAL WAR TO AN OVERT SHOOTING WAR. ARE THESE TRIAL  
21 RUNS TO SEE THE REACTION OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE?"

21

22                  NARRATOR: The war has now shifted from a  
23 paper and legal war to an overt shooting war. And we  
24 feel it's going to get far worse.

25

1           "IF THIS IS TRUE, THE REACTION OF THE AMERICAN  
2 PEOPLE PROVES TO THE ENEMIES OF OUR CONSTITUTION THAT WE  
3 ARE READY FOR A COMPLETE AND TOTAL TAKEOVER."

3

4           NARRATOR: They came against this thing to see  
5 what their reaction of the American people would be, and  
6 they found out that the American people cheered them on.  
7 So we are ready for a complete takeover.

8           A Spotlight put out a small publication on  
9 FEMA. In the case of Merge, a Blueprint, Case of  
10 Emergency, an executive orders blueprint for  
11 dictatorship also is one of their publications.

12           Now, an executive order is issued by the  
13 President of the United States. It does not go through  
14 the senate or the congress. He merely issues it. It's  
15 put in a federal register. And within 30 days, it has  
16 full effect of law, and nobody passes upon it.

17           Now, that's fine, and he has some rights to do  
18 that, but not contrary to the Constitution of the United  
19 States.

20           FEMA developed national security emergency  
21 plans for the regulation of immigration, nationals of  
22 enemy countries, plans to implement laws for the control  
23 of persons entering or leaving the United States,  
24 develop intergovernmental and interagency law  
25 enforcement plans and counter-terrorism programs to

1 interdict and respond to terrorism incidents in the  
2 United States that may result in a national security  
3 emergency.

4

5 "...TO INTERDECT AND RESPOND TO TERRORISM  
6 INCIDENTS IN THE UNITED STATES..."

6

7 NARRATOR: To interdict and respond to  
8 terrorism incidents in the United States. Now, this is  
9 a key that they're beginning to use.

10

11 "UNDER THE NEW CRIME CONTROL ACTS, A PROTESTER  
12 CAN BE CHARGED WITH TERRORISM. THESE ACTS CLEARLY  
13 VIOLATE THE CONSTITUTION."

13

14 NARRATOR: Under the new crime control acts,  
15 particularly under the crime control bill Number 8,  
16 which is now before the congress, a protester can be  
17 charged with terrorism.

18

19 "THIS PAVES THE WAY FOR THE GOVERNMENT TO  
20 DECLARE ALL THOSE WHO OPPOSE THE NEW WORLD ORDER AS  
21 TERRORISTS, AND IMPRISON THEM."

21

22 NARRATOR: And this paves the way for the  
23 government to declare all those who oppose the New World  
24 Order as terrorists and, therefore, imprison them,  
25 because you will be a political dissenter.

1                    "...TO DEVELOP...LAW ENFORCEMENT PLANS TO  
2 RESPOND TO CIVIL DISTURBANCES..."

3

4                    NARRATOR: To develop law enforcement plans to  
5 respond to civil disturbances. These people know  
6 perfectly well there's going to be major disturbance  
7 when this finally comes in.

8

9                    "ALL BASES COVERED. POLITICAL DISSENT IS NOT  
10 POSSIBLE. DEMONSTRATIONS ARE NOT POSSIBLE."

11                   NARRATOR: So they want all bases covered by  
12 law. So that's their rationale. They will legally be  
13 able to do this.

14                   You don't think it's going to happen, which is  
15 exactly the executive order issued by George Bush to  
16 quell the Los Angeles riots. When L.A. went under  
17 martial law, very few people understand what that means.  
18 But it means, in essence, that this constitution in Los  
19 Angeles was totally suspended.

20

21                   "...UNITS AND MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF  
22 THE UNITED STATES AND FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS  
23 WILL BE USED TO SUPPRESS THE VIOLENCE..."

23

24                   NARRATOR: And it says in there the units and  
25 members of the armed forces of the United States and

1 federal law enforcement officers will be used to  
2 suppress the violence. In other words, it's their  
3 officializing everything and that's what happens under  
4 martial law."

5

6 "...AND TO RESTORE LAW AND ORDER..."

7 "...OR MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL GUARD..."

8

9 NARRATOR: And to restore law and order, they  
10 can also call up members of the national guard. That's  
11 a key point. They're militarizing the nation. They're  
12 putting it under military law.

13

14 "LOS ANGELES WAS UNDER FULL MARTIAL LAW. IF  
15 AMERICANS DO NOT WANT THE NEW WORLD ORDER, AND RESIST,  
16 AMERICA WILL GO UNDER MARTIAL LAW."

16

17 NARRATOR: If Americans do not want the New  
18 World Order and they resist, America will go under  
19 immediate martial law rather than through the staged  
20 program into a martial law system, which is what the UN  
21 is.

22

23 "TO COORDINATE...ALL FEDERAL AGENCIES  
24 ASSISTING IN THE SUPPRESSION OF VIOLENCE...AND THE  
25 ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE..."

25



1           NARRATOR: Also included, to coordinate all  
2 federal agencies assisting in the suppression of  
3 violence and the administration of justice.

4

5           "MARTIAL LAW SUSPENDED THE CONSTITUTION OF THE  
6 UNITED STATES."

6

7           NARRATOR: Martial law suspends the  
8 Constitution of the United States.

9

10           "THE UN IS TO BE BROUGHT UP TO FULL POWER. IT  
11 WILL RULE VIA A THREE-TIER MILITARY MARTIAL LAW SYSTEM."

11

12           NARRATOR: The UN is to be brought up to full  
13 power. And it will rule through martial law via a  
14 three-tier military martial law system. The first one  
15 we're going to actually look at is called FinCEN.

16

17           "1. FINCEN UN TROOPS. FINCEN EQUIPMENT IS  
18 PAINTED BLACK WITH NO MARKINGS."

18

19           NARRATOR: And FinCEN, from the data we can  
20 get, it's not only a financial-controlling sector, but  
21 it has to do with other things.

22

23           Their equipment is black, and there are  
24 reports of a multitude of black helicopters all over the  
25 United States. We get calls on it virtually every day  
from someone who has just had it fly over the house.

1            "...BLACK PAINT SCHEMES ARE USED ON  
2            HELICOPTERS BY THE DRUG ENFORCEMENT AGENCY (DEA) AND  
3            U.S. ARMY SPECIAL OPERATIONS..."

3

4            NARRATOR: The FAA says black paint schemes  
5            are used on helicopters by the Drug Enforcement Agency  
6            and the U.S. Army Special Operations.

7

8            "AMERICAN CITIZENS ALL OVER THE UNITED STATES  
9            ARE SEEING BLACK HELICOPTERS WITH NO MARKINGS. FEDERAL  
10            AUTHORITIES HAVE NO COMMENT..."

11            "AN INFORMANT IN THE AIR RESERVE TOLD CIA  
12            MINISTRIES THAT HE PERSONALLY SAW A BLACK UNMARKED  
13            HELICOPTER IN A UN HANGAR."

14            "A MAN WHO CLAIMS HE WAS IN MILITARY  
15            INTELLIGENCE SAYS THE HELICOPTERS ARE UNITED NATIONS  
16            FINCEN AIRCRAFT."

17            "BECAUSE OF PUBLIC LAW 87-297, AND THE  
18            TRANSFER OF ALL MILITARY POWER OVER TO THE UNITED  
19            NATIONS, AND BECAUSE OF THE EXECUTIVE ORDERS SIGNED BY  
20            BUSH AND OTHERS..."

21            "THE EVIDENCE IS VERY STRONG THAT WE ARE  
22            SEEING THE FINAL PHASE OF STEP TWO IN THE DISARMAMENT  
23            AND TRANSFER PLAN SHOWN PREVIOUSLY."

24            "INASMUCH AS WE KNOW THE UNITED STATES MUST GO  
25            UNDER THE UNITED NATIONS, THEN THE BLACK HELICOPTERS  
26            MUST BE IN PREPARATION FOR THAT MOVE."

27            "BLACK HELICOPTERS HAVE ALSO BEEN ASSOCIATED  
28            MANY TIMES WITH THE UFO SIGHTINGS AND RECOVERY  
29            OPERATIONS."

30            "THESE FACTS, COUPLED WITH ARMY SPECIAL  
31            OPERATIONS, LEAD CIA TO CONCLUDE THE BLACK HELICOPTERS  
32            ARE CONNECTED TO IMPENDING MARTIAL LAW OPERATIONS."

1                   NARRATOR: Here is a map of FinCEN locations  
2 in the United States.

3

4                   "SO CALLED 'CONFIRMED' FINCEN TROOP DEPLOYMENT  
5 LOCATIONS IN THE UNITED STATES."

6

6                   NARRATOR: And these are confirmed, they  
7 claim. We have not been able to verify it. We're  
8 bringing this to you strictly unverified for troop  
9 deployment locations in the United States of America.  
10 There's been a fairly consistent reporting in Montana of  
11 UN combat groups.

12

13                   "2. UN COMBAT GROUPS, THE TOP TIER IN THE UN  
14 SYSTEM ENTRANCE TO U.S. BY PRESIDENTIAL EXECUTIVE  
15 ORDER - 11/11/90, PRESIDENT BUSH."

15

16                   NARRATOR: They are, in reality, the top tier  
17 in the UN system. And entrance to the U.S. was by  
18 Presidential Executive Order 11/11/90 signed by  
19 President Bush. And there are many battle group  
20 locations, and there are many multijurisdictional task  
21 force police.

22

23                   "3. THE MJTF POLICE, THE THIRD TIER OF THE UN  
24 POLICE FORCE. A US/UN FEDERAL POLICE FORCE."

24

25

1                   NARRATOR: Which are the third tier or the  
2 lowest on the UN police force. And it is, in reality,  
3 from what we can gather, is the federalization of the  
4 police forces in America and putting them, in reality,  
5 under the United Nations command, which we go under.

6

7                   "DETENTION CENTERS, CONCENTRATION CAMPS FOR  
8 DISSENTERS."

8

9                   NARRATOR: That would be for the detention  
10 centers, concentration camps for dissenters are part of  
11 this overall system for the roundup of people. Now, one  
12 of the largest ones is in Alaska.

13

14                   "THE ALASKAN CAMP IS THE BIGGEST, BEING  
15 ONE MILLION ACRES. IT IS LOCATED JUST OUTSIDE OF  
16 FAIRBANKS, AND IS SERVICED BY A SPUR LINE CALLED 'THE  
17 ALASKAN RAILROAD'."

16

17                   NARRATOR: Its being over one million acres,  
18 and it is located just outside of Fairbanks, according  
19 to reports, and is serviced by a spur line called the  
20 Alaskan Railroad.

21                   That's very interesting because under the  
22 emergency orders under FEMA, one of the railroads gets  
23 activated and falls under their control is the Alaskan  
24 Railway.

25

1                   "UNDER THE EXECUTIVE ORDERS, THE 'ALASKAN  
2 RAILWAY' FALLS UNDER THE EMERGENCY DOMAIN OF FEMA!"

3                   NARRATOR: And so we're beginning to find out  
4 that all of this goes together.

5  
6                   "THE ALASKAN CAMP WAS PURCHASED UNDER A  
7 'MENTAL HEALTH BILL'. ANYONE WHO DOES NOT AGREE WITH  
8 THE NWO IS 'MENTALLY ILL'."

9                   NARRATOR: The Alaskan camp was purchased  
10 under a mental health bill. And, of course, you have to  
11 understand that they are using mental health as one of  
12 their primary methods of warfare.

13  
14                   "IRON MOUNTAIN RECOMMENDATIONS OF AN  
15 'INQUISITION' FOR SOCIAL PURIFICATION ARE CONFIRMED BY  
16 JESUS CHRIST."

17                   NARRATOR: The Iron Mountain recommendations  
18 for an inquisition for social purification are also  
19 confirmed by the Lord Jesus Christ.

20                   "Then shall they deliver you up to be  
21 afflicted, and shall kill you. And ye shall be hated of  
22 all nations for my name's sake."

23                   This is predominantly a move against  
24 Christians and Jesus Christ.

25                   "And he shall speak great words against the

1 most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most  
2 High, and think to change times and laws..."

3 See, that's exactly what they're doing right  
4 now. They're changing all the laws.

5 "And it was given unto him to make war with  
6 the saints, and to overcome them. And power was given  
7 him over all upon kindreds, and tongues, and nations."

8 And in Revelation 17: "And I saw the woman  
9 drunken with the blood of the saint, and the blood of  
10 the martyrs of Jesus."

11 And this is actually, you're going to find  
12 out, has much to do with the United Nations.

13

14 "IRON MOUNTAIN SUBSTITUTE FOR WAR 'BLOOD  
15 GAMES' HAS BEEN IMPLEMENTED."

16 NARRATOR: Iron Mountain substitute for war  
17 blood games has been, in effect, implemented and is  
18 being carried out.

19 Ecological: Considering the shortcomings of  
20 war as a mechanism of selective population control, it  
21 might appear that devising substitutes for this function  
22 should be comparatively simple.

23 In other words, war kills off some people and  
24 so now we have to have an ecological substitute for that  
25 function.

1                   "IRON MOUNTAIN ECOLOGICAL SUBSTITUTE FOR WAR,  
2                   TOTAL POPULATION CONTROL."

3                   NARRATOR:  And it really boils down to  
4                   population control.  Current trends in warfare, the  
5                   increased strategic bombing of civilians and the greater  
6                   military importance now attached to the destruction of  
7                   sources of supply (as opposed to purely 'military' bases  
8                   and personnel) strongly suggest that a truly qualitative  
9                   improvement is in the making.

10

11                   "...INCREASED STRATEGIC BOMBING OF  
12                   CIVILIANS...DESTRUCTION OF SOURCES OF SUPPLY...A TRULY  
13                   QUALITATIVE IMPROVEMENT IS IN THE MAKING..."

13

14                   NARRATOR:  In other words, as we phase down  
15                   the war system, there's probably going to be one great  
16                   last one in their plans to really reduce the world  
17                   population.

18                   There is no question but that a universal  
19                   requirement that procreation be limited to the products  
20                   of artificial insemination would provide a fully  
21                   adequate substitute control for the population.

22

23                   "...A UNIVERSAL REQUIREMENT THAT PROCREATION  
24                   BE LIMITED TO PRODUCTS OF ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION..."

24

25

1                   NARRATOR: A universal requirement that  
2 procreation be limited to products. See how they treat  
3 people?

4

5                   "...CONCEPTION AND EMBRYONIC GROWTH TAKING  
6 PLACE WHOLLY UNDER LABORATORY CONDITIONS - WOULD EXTEND  
7 THESE CONTROLS TO THEIR LOGICAL CONCLUSION."

7

8                   NARRATOR: Conception and embryonic growth  
9 taking place wholly under embryonic conditions would  
10 extend these controls to their logical conclusion.

11

12                   "TOTAL AND COMPLETE CONTROL OF EVERY HUMAN  
13 BEING BORN. PRESELECTED TO BE A SLAVE TO THE RICH MEN  
14 OF THE EARTH."

14

15                   NARRATOR: Now, total and complete control,  
16 this is what this means, of every human being born.  
17 They will be preselected genetically to be a slave to  
18 the rich men of the earth, is the system they're setting  
19 up.

20

21                   "INTERMEDIATE STEP - TOTAL CONTROL OF  
22 CONCEPTION WITH A VARIANT OF THE PILL, VIA WATER  
23 SUPPLIES OR ESSENTIAL FOOD STUFFS..."

23

24                   NARRATOR: They have an intermediate step,  
25 total control of conception with a variant of the pill,



1 via water supplies or essential food stuffs. In other  
2 words, they intend when they bring in this new system,  
3 they will stop the growth of the population. They will  
4 put an end to the food or the water supplies, and then  
5 they would offset it.

6

7 "...OFFSET BY A CONTROLLED 'ANTIDOTE' - IS  
8 ALREADY UNDER DEVELOPMENT..."

8

9 NARRATOR: Then they would offset it by a  
10 controlled substance so that it could be countermanded  
11 and the woman become pregnant. And they claim in Iron  
12 Mountain that it was already under investigation and  
13 under work back in 1961.

14

15 "INTERPRETATION...THE MANDATORY MASS  
16 STERILIZATION OF THE HUMAN RACE WITH THE ANTIDOTE IN THE  
17 HANDS OF THE UNITED NATIONS."

17

18 NARRATOR: So the interpretation is the  
19 mandatory mass sterilization of the human race with them  
20 in total control of all the antidotes for it.

21 Excess population, Iron Mountain says, is war  
22 material. As long as any society must contemplate even  
23 a remote possibility of war, it must maintain a maximal  
24 supportable population.

25

1                    "...EXCESS POPULATION IS WAR  
2 MATERIAL...(CANNON FODDER) IS THE TERM USED BY THE ELITE  
3 AT THE WORLD WILDERNESS CONGRESS."

3    \* \* \* \*

4                    UNKNOWN SPEAKER:  When the auditor finally  
5 gets his hands on the balance sheet, I suggest,  
6 therefore, that this be sold not through a democratic  
7 process.  That would take too long and require far too  
8 much of the funds to educate the cannon fodder,  
9 unfortunately, which populates the earth.

10                    We have to take almost an elitist program that  
11 we can see the cannon fodder's belly and look to the  
12 future in time frames and in results, which are not  
13 easily understood or to which can be, with intellectual  
14 honesty, be reduced down to some kind of simplistic  
15 definition.

16    \* \* \* \*

17                    "JESUS CHRIST WARNED THAT A TIME WOULD COME IN  
18 WHICH THE LOVE OF MANY WOULD GROW COLD, AND WORLD  
19 GOVERNMENT WOULD COME.  IT IS HERE..."
